[It is clearly and distinctly understood and acknowledged that this Agreement has been executed by SIU, on behalf of Symbiosis Centre for International Education [SCIE], one of its Departments. Therefore, all the rights and obligations as provided in this Agreement shall be exercised /		

Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE) is a department of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) and is engaged in providing leadership and support to internationalize the campus and the curricula. International students from over 85 countries pursue their undergraduate and postgraduate studies at Symbiosis and SCIE aims to provide the Students and faculty with opportunities to pursue their international academic interests to the fullest, be it through academic exchanges, or exposure to international conferences, seminars, workshops, and other resources;

performed by SCIE on behalf of SIU and hence SIU in this Agreement hereafter be construed as

SIU and ABCE agree to engage in academic cooperation in areas of mutual interest.









The areas for mutual academic cooperation, where mutual benefits can be identified, may include the following.

- 1. Articulation agreements allowing students to progress to higher awards.
- 2. Collaborative teaching including the joint training and supervision of Masters and PhD degree students.
- 3. Collaborative research.
- 4. Exchange of information on research and education programmes.
- 5. Exchange of research publications and University publications.
- 6. Exchange visits by staff and students.
- 7. Joint proposals and engagement in research and training programmes sponsored by funding agencies.

SIU and ABCE will enter into independent and detailed agreements in respect of the above, once the activity is identified and finalised.

This MoU is valid for a period of five years from the date from which it is first signed. In the event of either party desirous to change or terminate the agreement, notice in writing must be given at least six months in advance of the proposed date of change or termination.

For the purpose of this document the legal representatives of the aforesaid University and School are the Dean of ABCE and the Registrar of SIU
