Objectives of TAAL

TAAL is broadly based on the New Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) of the Government of India. NEP 2020 envisions India as a Global Study Centre supporting high-quality, holistic and multidisciplinary education. Aiming at providing stimulating and engaging learning experiences for all students and making extensive use of technology in teaching and learning, it highly recommends, 'empowering the faculty to conduct innovative teaching, research, and service as they see best will be a key motivator and enabler for them to do truly outstanding, creative work'. The policy envisages that the 'curriculum, pedagogy, continuous assessment, and student support are the cornerstones for quality learning'. The focus of NEP is thus to create motivated, energized and capable faculty. Technology is now an integral part of education and creating the ability to leverage technology amongst faculty and introspect on its use in effective student engagement is critical. The major objectives of the TAAL programme is to introduce faculty members from all domains across Maharashtra to

- get equipped with the modern contemporary concepts in higher education
- gain better understanding of best methods and practices of teaching to adult learner
- know the basics of effective andragogical practices
- understand the techno-pedagogical tools used for teaching and assessment
- get hands-on training to use technology for interactive classrooms
- get aware of planning and implementing these practices effectively in their face to face, online and hybrid classrooms
