INTRODUCTION

As Officiating Controller of Examinations of Symbiosis International (Deemed University), I am happy to present the annual report of the Exam Department for the Academic Year 2017-18.

The 14th convocation of the University was held at the University campus on 17th December 2017. The Hon'ble Minister for Finance, Government of India Shri Arun Jaitley was the Chief Guest for the convocation. Total 5500 students were eligible for the convocation (Degree and Diploma).

A honorary D.Litt. (Honoris Causa) was awarded to Mr. Rahul Bajaj, for his pioneering contributions to business, industry and corporate social responsibility and Prof. Dr. Philip Altbach, for his Scholarly contribution to International and Indian Higher Education. Total 9 students were the proud winners of Gold medals. The Best Outgoing International student award was given to Ms. Marzia Rahmanyar from Afghanistan. Total 31 scholars were awarded the Doctorate in Philosophy. (Ph. D.)

Global Immersion Programme (GIP) is a special feature wherein students study courses offered by Foreign Universities. This year 167 students took the programme and acquired credits. This global experience provides them an opportunity to transform into a global persona.

Students who were not able to complete the programme within the validity due to medical, financial or personal issue were given a special chance to appear for the examinations so they could complete the programme and could get Degree. 74 students were permitted to use this special opportunity, 42 students could complete the programme and were eligible for award of Degree.




GLOBAL IMMERSION PROGRAMME (GIP):

Average pass percentage for the Academic Year 2017-18 (Degree Programmes - Regular Batches)




Programme wise No. of students appeared & passed in the final year examination 2017-18
