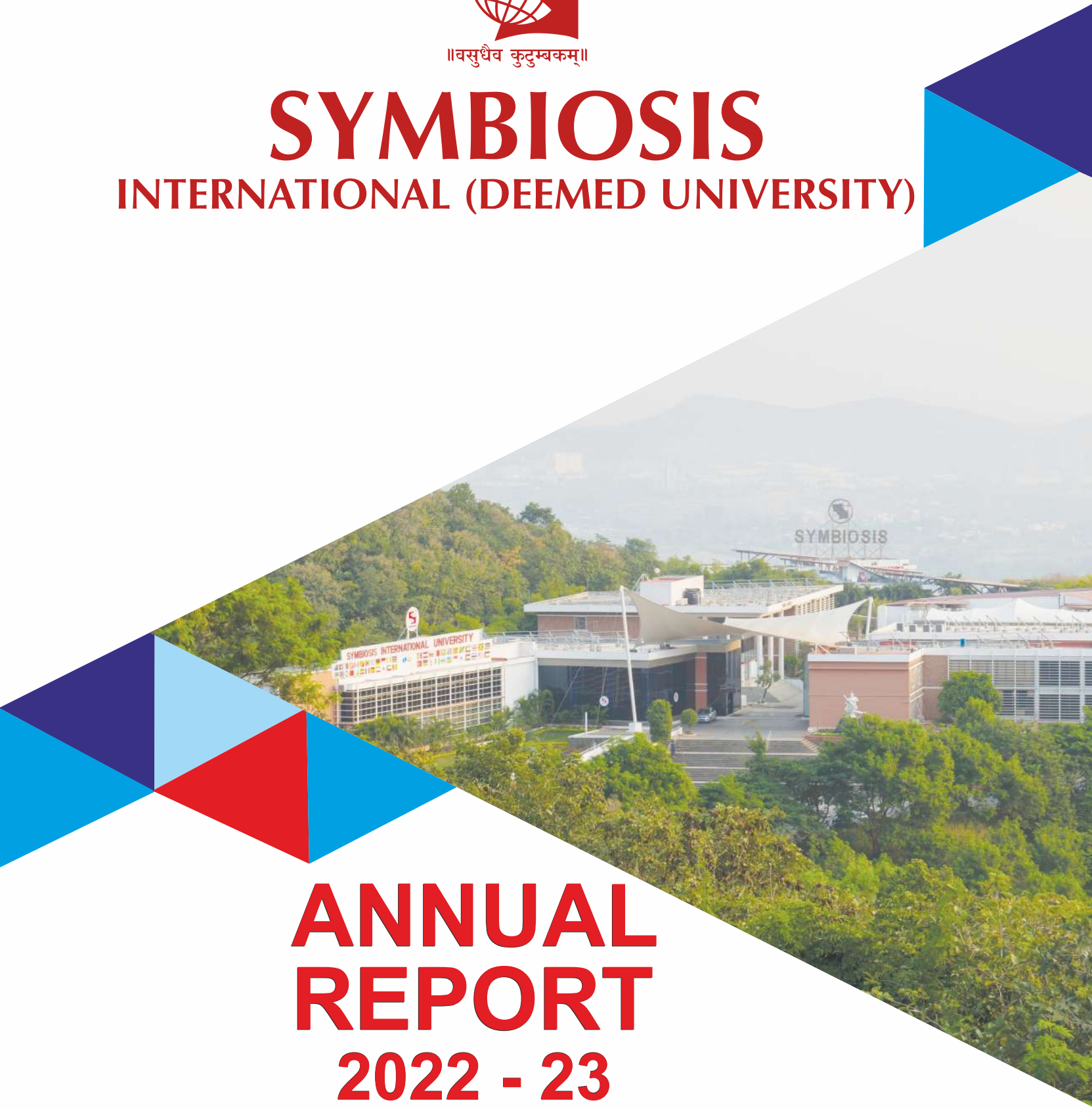

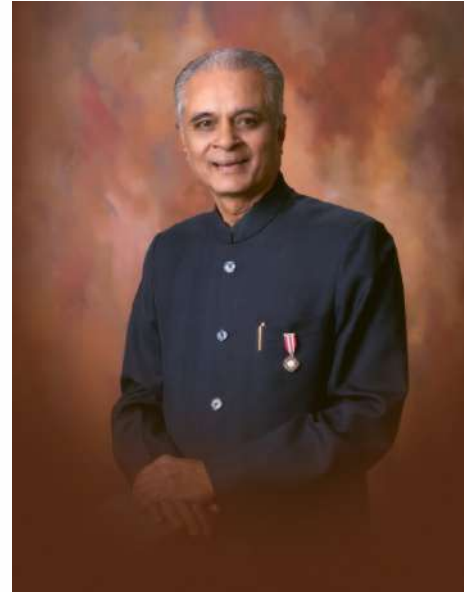

Dr. S. B. Mujumdar is the Founder and President of Symbiosis – a multi-national, multi-lingual and multidisciplinary educational complex of repute. A distinguished academician and educationist, he is also the Chancellor of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) (SIU).

Dr. Mujumdar had his school education at Gadhinglaj and college education at Kolhapur and Pune. In his Master's Degree (M.Sc.) in Botany, he stood first class first with distinction in Pune University. He obtained his Doctorate (Ph.D.) in Microbiology from Pune University. He joined Fergusson College, Pune as Professor and Head of Department of Botany which position he held for 20 years. He was a member of the Pune University's Executive Council, the Senate, Academic Council and Chairman of the Board of Studies in Botany.

Deeply touched by the hardships suffered by the foreign students - especially Afro Asian students - studying in Pune, he established in 1971 'SYMBIOSIS' with a view to help them and provide them a 'Home away from Home'. He soon realized that education is the best medium for promoting international understanding. He, therefore, started establishing educational institutions imparting quality instruction in diverse disciplines.

Dr. Mujumdar is the recipient of many awards / honors. The Government of India has conferred on him 'Padma Shri' in 2005 and 'Padma Bhushan' in 2012. Tilak Maharashtra Vidhyapeeth has conferred on him 'D. Litt.' in 2016. He is recipient of first 'Dr. APJ Abdul kalam Memorial Award' in 2016. He has received Punya Bhushan Award (2009).

During India's G20 Presidency, Symbiosis International University exemplified its commitment to this noble cause by hosting a series of prestigious events, including Youth20 (Y20), Universities 20 (Uni20), and G20 University Connect. The Y20 was hosted in collaboration with the Ministry of Youth & Sports Affairs Govt. of India. The Uni20 was hosted in collaboration with the Association of Indian Universities (AIU). These gatherings brought together distinguished professionals, experts, and scholars from all G20 and many other countries representing the education and industry sectors. The participation of these esteemed delegates enriched the exchange of knowledge, ideas, and perspectives, further solidifying our global network of collaboration.

In our pursuit of excellence, Symbiosis International (Deemed University) has achieved remarkable recognition in various national and international rankings. The University now stands at an impressive 32nd position among over 1000 Indian universities by the National Institute Ranking Framework (NIRF). Symbiosis Institute of Business Management (SIBM), Pune, holds the 17th position, while Symbiosis Law School (SLS), Pune, stands proudly at the number 6 position.

On the international level, SIU has secured its position among the top 400 universities in Asia and is ranked 78th in Southern Asia by the QS World Ranking Agency. Additionally, SIU boasts a global ranking between 801-1000 and holds the 23rd position in India by the Times Higher Education Asia University Ranking Survey 2023. Notably, in subject-specific rankings by Times Higher Education World University Rankings 2023, SIU ranks between 401-500 in Social Sciences & Computer Sciences, between 501-600 in Business & Economics and Accounting & Finance, and between 601-800 in Engineering. Several constituent institutes of SIU have also earned top-10 rankings from various agencies.

In the year 2022-23, Symbiosis welcomed a new member to the family: Symbiosis Institute of Business Management (SIBM) Noida. Furthermore, SIU launched five new Centers, viz. Symbiosis Centre for Engagement with Africa, Symbiosis Centre for Ambedkar Studies, Symbiosis Centre for promoting the philosophy of 'Vasudhaiv Kutumbakam', Symbiosis Centre for Research in Media and Creative Industries, and Symbiosis Centre for Research in Vaccines and Biologicals.

Today, the University has more than 30,000 students studying at the Constituents from all the states of India and from over 85 countries, providing a home away from home for Indian and foreign students. The University has been awarded Category-I status by UGC, and an 'A++' grade by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). It has been ranked 32nd in India by National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2023, and 10th by Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievement (ARIIA) 2021. Internationally, the Times Higher Education (THE) World University Ranking 2023 has ranked the University amongst the top 1000 Universities in the World, and 23rd in India. THE World University Rankings 2023 by Subject has ranked the university in the 401-500 band in Social Sciences, in the 501-600 band in Business & Economics, in the 501-600 band in Accounting & Finance, in the 401- 500 band in Computer Science, and in the 601-800 band in Engineering. QS World University Rankings has ranked the university amongst the top 351- 400 in QS Asia University Rankings 2023, and 78th in QS Asia University Rankings 2023 – Southern Asia.

The main campus of the University is nestled on a beautiful 400-acre land at Lavale in Pune, Maharashtra, India. Today the University has 40 constituents, 12 Research Centres, 12 Support Departments and 10 Departments of Skills & Continuing Education spread across Pune, Nasik, Nagpur, Bengaluru, Hyderabad and NOIDA.

The University has academic collaborations with reputed foreign universities like the University of Cologne - Germany, University of Queensland – Australia, Aston University – UK, University of Leeds – UK, Washburn University – USA, Nanyang Technological University in Singapore, University of Houston in USA, Berlin School of Economics and Law in Germany, University of Malaya – Malaysia, and many more.

The University's Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE) promotes internationalization and invites international students to the Symbiosis International (Deemed University) for a Semester Abroad Programme. The University is actively involved with student and faculty exchange programmes and has also introduced the Scholar- in- Residence Programme. SCIE conducts intensive 'Study India' programme for the benefit of international students from over 85 countries that study here. A

variety of activities are organised where international students of Pune city are able to meet on a common platform and display their many talents.

Cutting edge technologies, smart classrooms and modern infrastructure positively impact the delivery of world class education. Diversity in the classroom and faculty rooms, service learning projects, internships and value-added activities lead to a more holistic development of students. Access to several learning resources via the library, availability of housing facilities on several campuses, scholarship programmes to promote academic excellence, several co-curricular and sports activities organised by the University facilitate well rounded overall development of students.

The University has established several research centres led by the researchers of repute in respective disciplines. 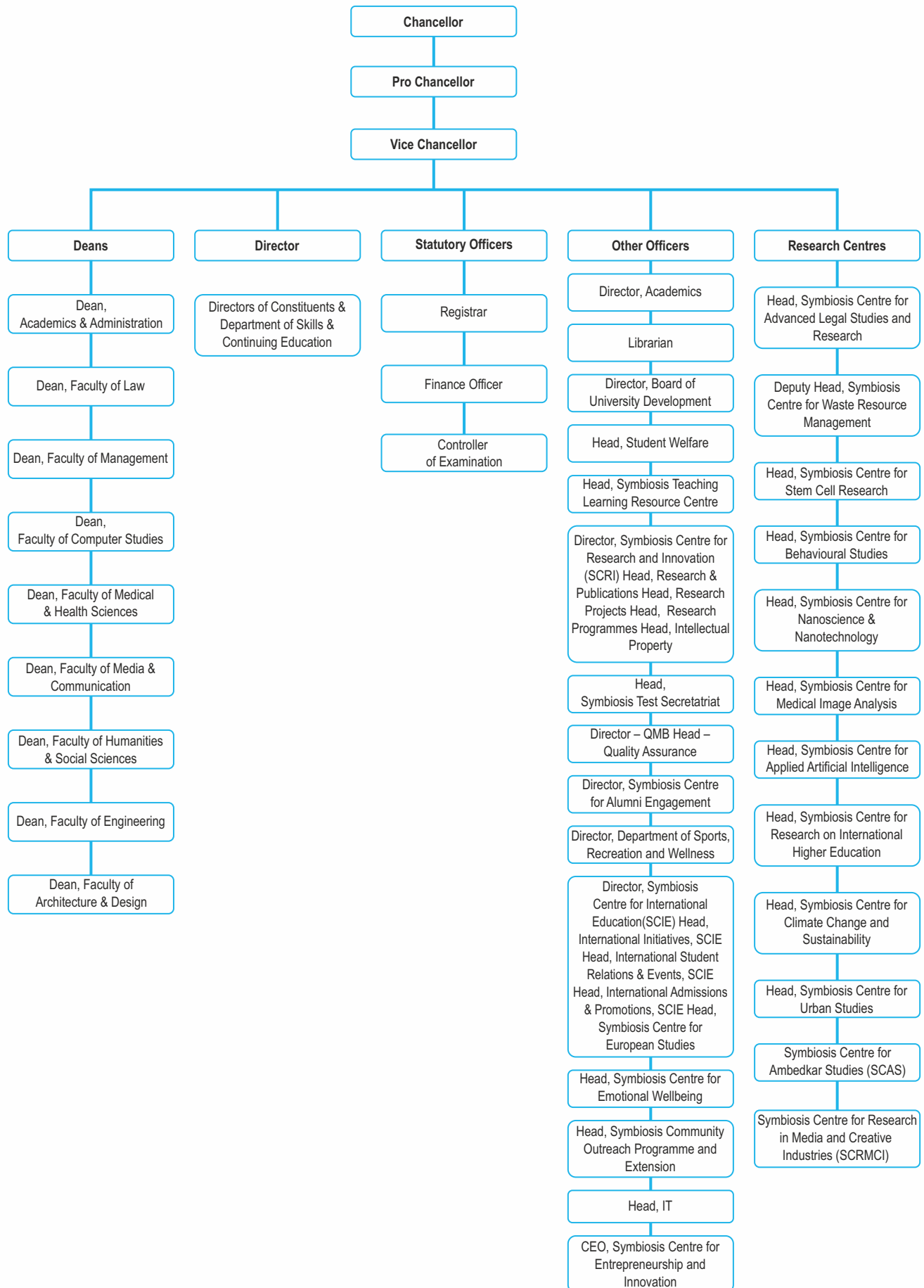

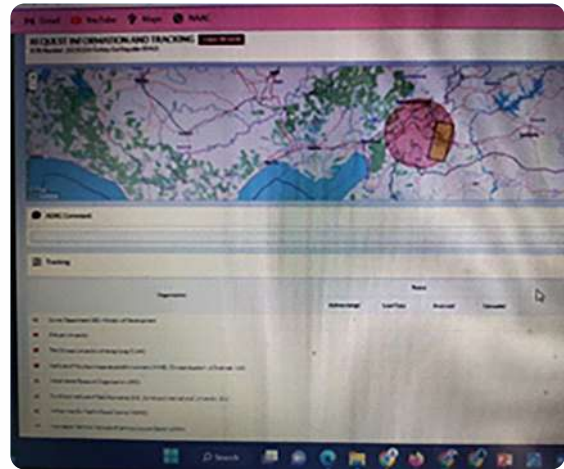

Admissions

The University conducts all India-level entrance examinations for students who wish to pursue Doctoral, Post Graduate, and Under Graduate programmes offered by the University.

Candidates aspiring to join the MBA programme offered by constituents of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) must appear for the common, mandatory Symbiosis National Aptitude (SNAP) Test conducted in December /January every year. For admission to the MBA programmes for AY 2022-23, SNAP 2021 was conducted as a Computer Based Test (CBT) across various cities of India in the months of December 2021 and January 2022. SNAP 2021 was conducted thrice for the academic year 2022-2023. A candidate could appear for a maximum of two tests for SNAP 2021, and the best of his/her score was considered for percentile calculation.

Candidates aspiring to join B. ALL.B./ B.B. ALL. B / BCA/ BBA(IT)/ B.A. (M.C)/ B. Sc (Economics) Hons. / B.A. (Liberal Arts)/ B.Sc (Liberal Arts) / B.Sc (Culinary Arts) / B.Tech / B.Sc. (Applied Statistics and Data Science) programmes offered by constituents of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) have to appear for the mandatory entrance tests. Since 2018, the SET - Law test is known as Symbiosis Law Admission Test (SLAT), SET - Design test, Symbiosis Entrance Exam for Design (SEED), SET - Engineering as Symbiosis Institute of Technology Engineering Entrance Exam (SITEEE) and SET - General as SET.

To pursue a doctoral programme at the University, candidates have to appear for the Ph.D. Entrance test (PET) examinations.

SET/SLAT/SITEEE tests for the academic year 2022-2023 were conducted in July 2022 in a Computer Based Test (CBT) across various cities of India. PET was conducted in home proctored mode wherein candidates were able to appear for PET from their home.

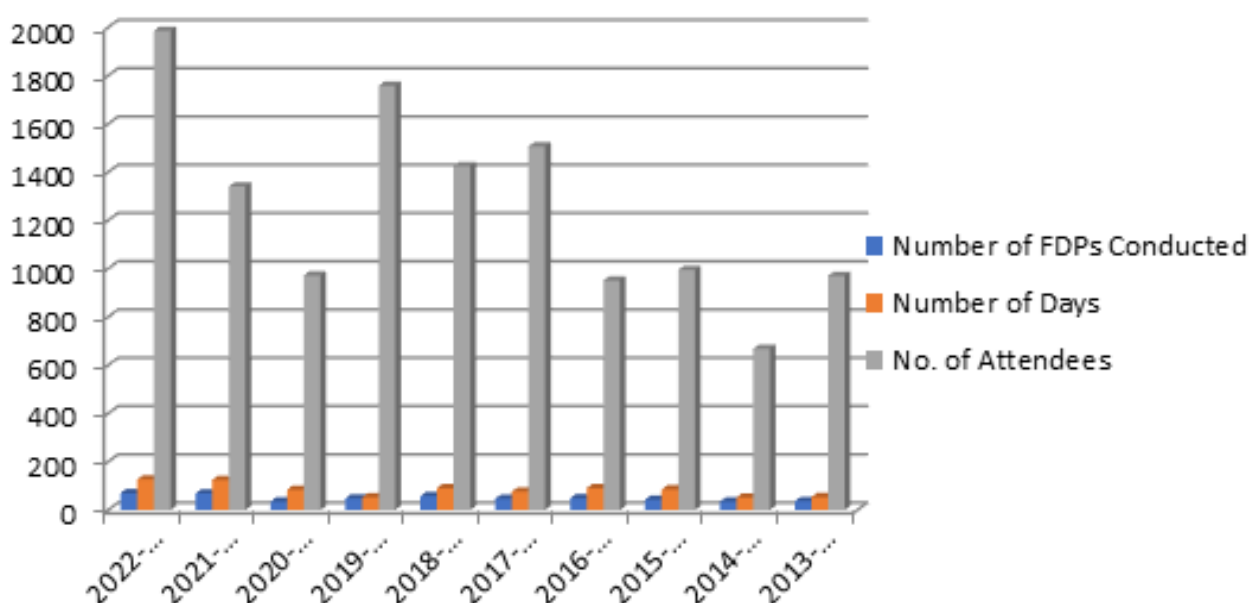

Faculty Development Programmes

Faculty Development Programmes (FDP) are conducted regularly at the University to enhance the teaching skills and research capabilities of the faculty members. The department organized 70 FDPs which were conducted in 127 days during this academic year.

Symbiosis International (Deemed University) in association with Maharashtra State Faculty Development Academy (MSFDA) organized a Faculty Development Programme on Techno-pedagogy and Andragogy for Active Learning (TAAL). The TAAL is a '8 days programme' conducted by Symbiosis Teaching Learning Resource Centre (STLRC), in three phases: Phase I – 5 days Residential programme, Phase II – 2 days Online Workshop and Phase III – 1day Refresher. In 2022-23 three batches of TAAL were conducted in which faculty members from higher education institutions across the state of Maharashtra from varied disciplines had participated. 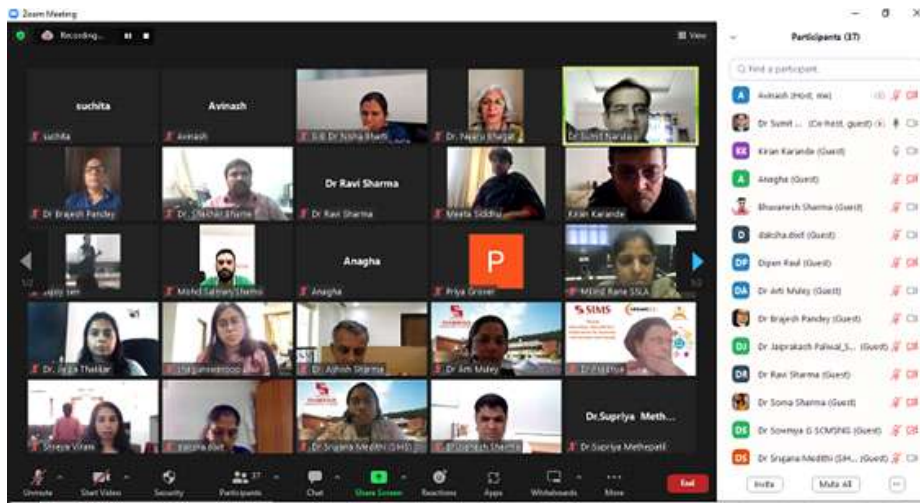

Research

The University has established the Symbiosis Centre for Research and Innovation (SCRI), which is a dedicated department for promoting and facilitating research among students and faculty. Through its academic and administrative services, SCRI enables researchers to achieve excellence in their work, and eventually, translates SIU's vision of creation of knowledge for the benefit of the Society into reality. The University has established several Research centres led by the researchers of repute in respective disciplines.

Research Centres:

Symbiosis Centre for Nanoscience and Nanotechnology (SCNN)

Symbiosis Centre for Nanoscience and Nanotechnology has been established in 2017 considering that potential impact of Nanoscience and Nanotechnology on evolution of Science, technology and societal growth. The Centre envisages promoting basic and applied research in the fields of healthcare, technology and environment, with primary impetus to fulfill national strategic needs. The major ventures of the centre are synthesis of advanced functional nano-materials, fabrication of nano-micro-devices, & its multidisciplinary applications. The major thrust of centre includes opportunities for international research collaborations; conduction of seminars/ workshops/ conferences/ extension lectures to promote Nanoscience & Nanotechnology to common people and to bridge the gap between nanotechnology research and its social acceptance.

Symbiosis Centre for Stem Cell Research (SCSCR)

The centre is unique, as it is the only research centre in Pune that will perform research exclusively on stem cells. Research in Experimental Hematology at a cellular and molecular level will be carried out with respect to aging of stem cells, microenvironment – mediated regulation of hematopoietic stem cells, leukemia/lymphoma biology, development of 3D cultures, mesenchymal stem cell biology with special focus on exosomes and micro-vesicles and signal transduction. Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Ministry of Science & Technology, Government of India has identified Stem Cell Research as one of the most exciting fields of life science in view of its potential clinical applications. With this understanding Symbiosis Centre for Stem Cell Research will serve in strengthening research in one of the targeted areas as identified by DBT's Medical Biotechnology programme.

Symbiosis Centre for Behavioural Studies (SCBS)

Keeping in mind that experimental research methods have a rich academic tradition both in psychology and marketing, Symbiosis Centre for Behavioural Studies has been established with aim to conduct experimental research in order to publish quality research papers in reputed journals. Its allied agenda of providing consultancy to organizations has also been kept in mind while marshaling the centre amongst industry and academia.

Symbiosis Centre for Waste Resource Management (SCWRM)

Symbiosis International (Deemed University) in the year 2015, established Symbiosis Centre for Waste Resource Management (SCWRM) to be a pioneer in building knowledge, disseminating awareness and improving practices in the area of sustainable waste management. The centre promotes inter- and multi-disciplinary approach for basic and need-based, applied research and efforts in bridging the gap between lab and society with respect to solid and liquid waste management. The centre is involved in conducting workshops, training, and awareness programs to promote national agenda of 'Swachh Bharat Mission. The centre also works towards developing academic curriculum for undergraduate and post graduate courses. Furthermore, SCWRM is committed to interdisciplinary approach to develop insights, build awareness, and seek to identify, analyze, and implement key issues and challenges pertaining to waste management and sustainability involving all levels of stakeholder's viz. Government, statutory bodies, policy makers, corporates, academia, research institutes, civil society and many others. A key activity of SCWRM involves providing professional technical consultancy to various stakeholders in the field of solid waste management. SCWRM has consultancy projects with Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC), APMC Mumbai, Lonavala Municipal Corporation etc. on diverse aspects of municipal waste management. The centre is also an empaneled technical agency with the Government of Maharashtra to implement the national GOBAR-DHAN scheme in Maharashtra state at district levels under Swachh Bharat Mission (G)-II. The centre has several national and international collaborations to develop a network of researchers across the globe to address the issue of waste management and climate change.

Symbiosis Centre for Medical Image Analysis (SCMIA)

In recent years there has been an increased thrust to understand and quantify the complex information conveyed by medical images. Developing modern computational techniques that offer the potential for extracting diverse and complex information from imaging data and applying the setoaplethora of clinical studies is crucial. These techniques not only support precise quantification but also overcome the limitations of subjective visual interpretation. Furthermore, these methods can facilitate finding specific markers that relate to pathologies as well as aid in treatment planning. Building on this background, the objectives of this center are as follows:

- Development of novel computer-based image analysis methods and their application to a wide variety of clinical research studies
- Translating the techniques to the clinic thereby aiding early diagnosis and understanding of the underlying pathology.

Currently, the center focuses on neuroimaging (MRI) and breast imaging (ultrasound). Image analysis methodologies include volumetric analysis, diffusion MRI processing and analysis, structural and functional connect omics, statistical learning in imaging, radiomics, population-based analysis and deep neural networks for image classification. In future, the center plans to diversify research to image analysis of various organs and include multiple modalities in imaging

Symbiosis Centre for Applied Artificial Intelligence (SCAAI)

Symbiosis Centre for Applied AI (SCAAI) was established in May 2019 and is affiliated to Symbiosis Centre for Research and Innovation (SCRI). SCAAI is a constituent of Symbiosis International (Deemed University). The primary aim of this centre is to spearhead the advancement and novel developments in various application areas and promotion of the advanced research and education in the field of AI. Along with this SCAAI engages in interdisciplinary research to address pertinent issues that could involve a huge spectrum such as finance and banking to healthcare.

Symbiosis Centre for Advanced Legal Studies and Research (SCALSAR)

Symbiosis Centre for Advanced Legal Studies and Research (SCALSAR) was informally organized in 2007 and formalized in February 2013 by the Board of Management, SIU. It has been established to facilitate advanced legal studies and research. SCALSAR facilitates and provides:

- The means including idea architecture and resources for advanced legal studies for post graduate, including LLM students and PhD Students.
- Infrastructure and resources for advanced legal research to the faculty, researchers and post graduate students promoting and facilitating publications in SCOPUS, Web of Science and UGC recognised journals
- To collaborate with institutes under the faculty and departments within SIU, National and International Universities and Agencies for research, consultation, training and extension
- Research, training and consultancy in selected areas of 4 excellence centres aligned with SIU clusters, other research centres and contemporary areas of national and global importance
- Interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary studies and research while interlinking with SIU research clusters
- To act as a think-tank to the Government, hosts Scholars in residence, undertake interdisciplinary legal studies and research projects, train teachers and design training modules.
- Collaboration with institutes under the faculty and departments within SIU, National and International Universities and Agencies for research, consultation, training and extension
- To disseminate and ensure the outcome of research, training, advocacy and consultation to stakeholders including businesses, law makers, government and non-governmental entities, people of India and the world
- Positive and measurable impact on the society and justice system through inclusive research and training

Symbiosis Center for Urban Studies (SCUS)

The Centre will be operational from the AY 2022-23, and will undertake activities to focus on Capacity Building, and being responsible for creating human capital to help transform India's urban landscape.

Research activities of the Centre will include:

- Organizing Guest Lectures Workshop, Seminars, Symposiums, Conferences, Hackathon.
- Strengthen the PhD Department under this specialization

- Collaborative Inter-disciplinary Research with our sister institutions
- To provide excellent opportunities to collaborate with supranational institutions and urban diplomacy
- To collaborate with leading think tanks and organizations supporting the Indian urban agenda

Symbiosis Center for Climate Change and Sustainability (SCCCS)

The SCCCS is established with the following proposed activities:

- Collaborative Research in thematic areas
- PhD program, post-doctoral research
- Education by developing courses in Climate Change for UG & PG institutions
- Social Outreach by conducting Workshops, lectures, taking up Restoration projects, Park / Devrai conservation.

Symbiosis Center for Research on International Higher Education (SCRIHE)

SCRIHE is established for conducting research in the area of international higher education. The NEP 2020 has earmarked a whole chapter on Internationalization of Higher Education. With the COVID pandemic, there have been different challenges that higher education faced, but one positive outcome has been internationalization at home. Collaborative online international learning, co-teaching and co-learning have been promoted due to online education. New concepts of international co-operation and intra- regional cooperation have emerged which enhance the internationalization of Higher Education. Knowledge diplomacy and how higher education can be a tool for development and soft power is also coming into discussion at the global level.

Research Projects

The researchers at the University have a record of attracting external funding for their research proposals from several Government and Non-Government agencies. Research grants from reputed agencies are a manifestation of the research capabilities of the University. SIU supports faculty members with seed money for their research ideas by inviting proposals for Minor Research Projects (MRPs), Student Research Projects (SRPs) and Major Research Projects (MJRPs). Total amount of Rs.73.37 Lakhs was provided this year as seed money for Research Projects. And Rs.537.16 Lakhs Research Project Funding was received/sanctioned by the University in 2022-23 from Government, Non- Government External Agencies.

Research Publications

For the last one decade, the University has focused and made consistent efforts to encourage the faculty members to undertake research and publish the same in good scholarly journals indexed in Scopus and Web of Science. The number of publications indexed in Scopus has increased substantially from 25 in 2010-11 to 6300 publications as of 31st August 2023.

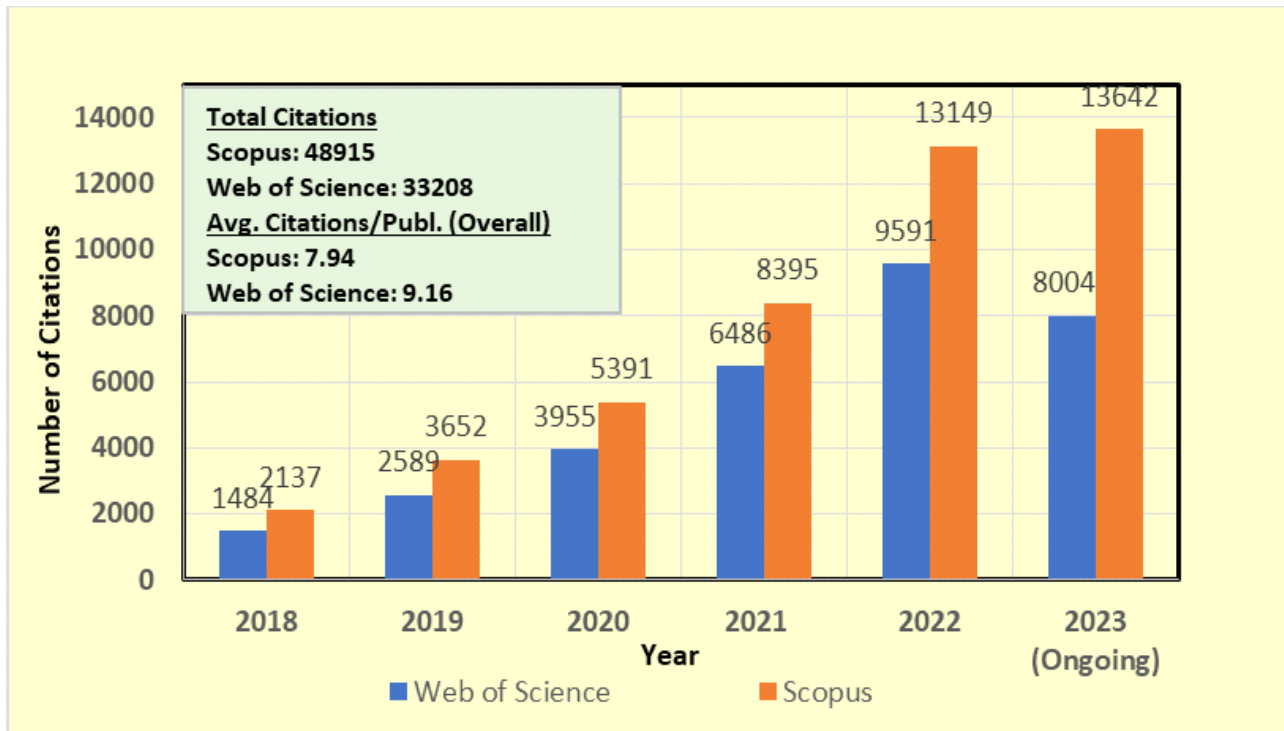


Figure 2 - Number of Citations in Scopus and Web of Science in last 5 years

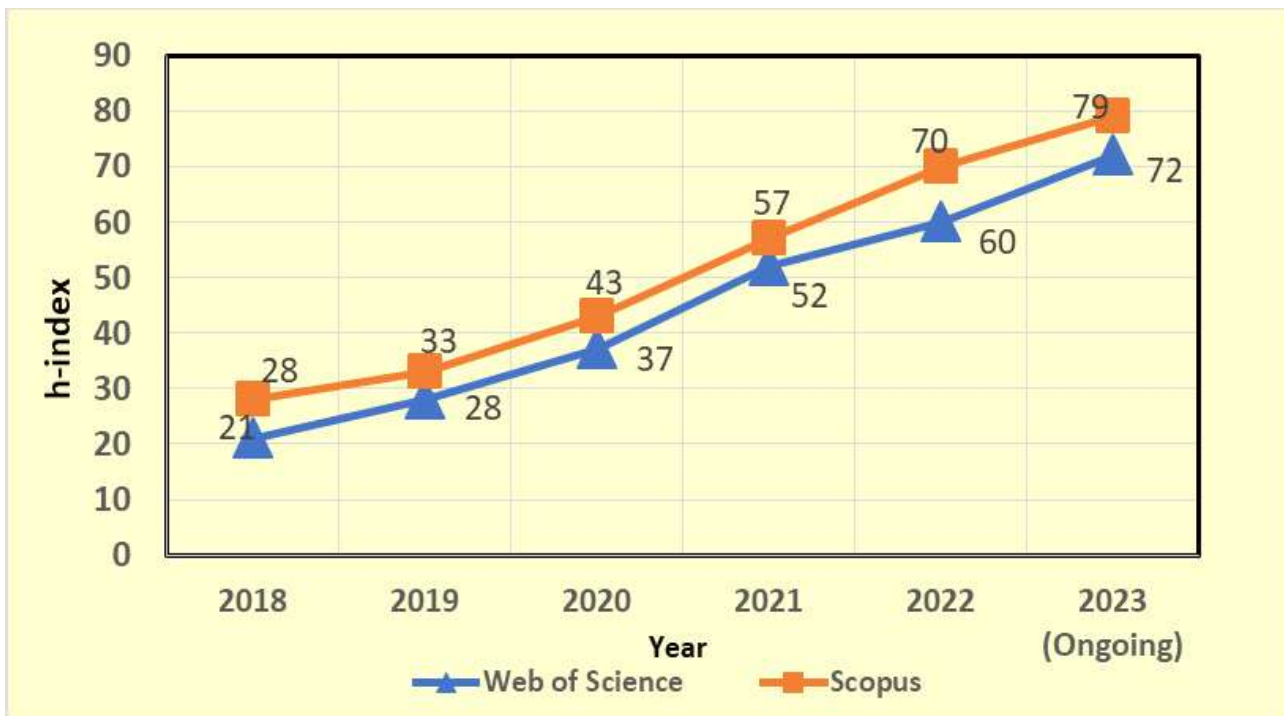


Figure 3 - h- index in 5 years (Scopus and Web of Science Journals)

In the AY 2022-23, a total of 1380 and 1111 research papers were published in journals indexed in Scopus and Web of Science (SCIE, SSCI, AHCI, ESCI), respectively, as shown in Table 1. of which, 438 papers are published in Q1 category journals indicating quality scholarly literature generated from the University. Over a period of time, the number of citations, h-index, i10-index and average citations per publications of SIU research publications are also increasing exponentially thereby indicating the quality (see Table 2 and Fig. 1 & 3), while Fig. 2 depicts the number of publications in Scopus and Web of Science in last 5 years. In 2022-23, there were 372 papers published in Q1 and Q2 category Scopus / WoS journals.

As regards to intellectual property, the university has filed/published 46 national and international patents, 4 design applications filed/registered and 4 copyright applications.

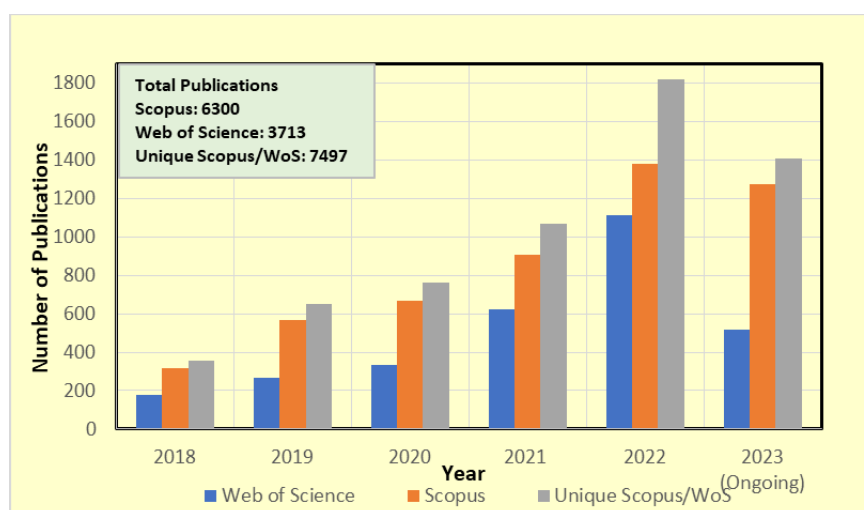

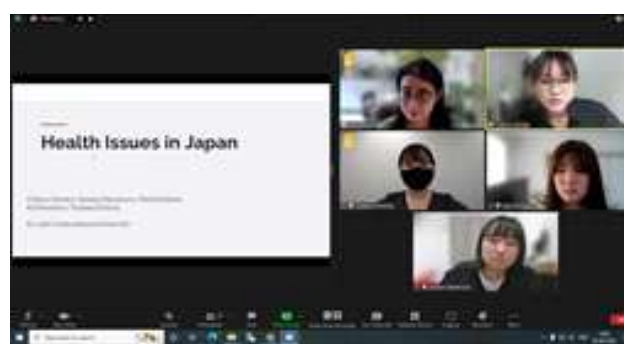
Joint Online Program with Mainz University, Germany

Community Outreach Initiatives:

Symbiosis Community Outreach Programme and Extension (SCOPE) through its twin arms of healthcare and non-health initiatives is working towards a sustainable, comprehensive and integrated development of the identified villages located in the vicinity of the main campus of the university at Mulshi taluka of Pune district.

SCOPE works towards positively impacting the community as a part of its healthcare and non-healthcare initiatives. Healthcare provides preventive, promotive, and curative healthcare services to the identified needy population of the 35 identified villages belonging to the marginalized populations residing in various access-compromised regions of Mulshi taluka. The health care unit provides regular health check-ups in the form of fixed village scheduled OPDs and general health check-up camps at identified sites like brick kilns, construction sites, schools, etc. The identified high-risk cases are referred to Symbiosis University Hospital and Research Centre (SUHRC) for further investigations and treatment which is free of charge to the patients. The team also coordinates and conducts annual mega healthcare service delivery activities like Bhima Koregaon and Wari Healthcare services, the Pulse Polio Immunization campaign, and Health check-ups for Jail inmates. SCOPE has effectively organized numerous such programs where Key Opinion Leaders (KOLs) of the community, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), and government stakeholders.

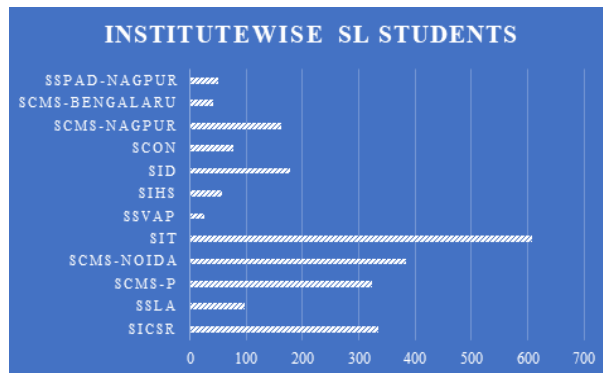
