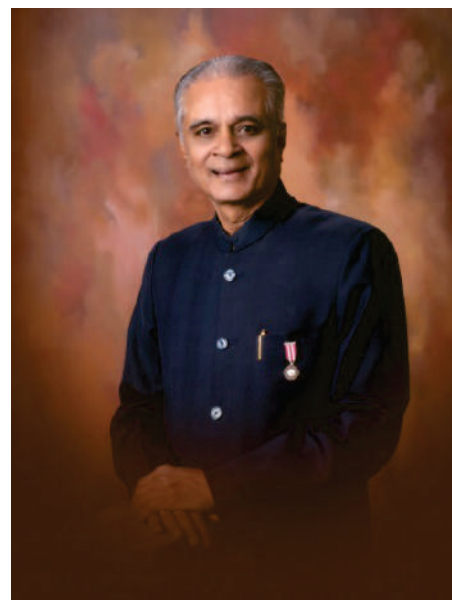

Dr. S. B. Mujumdar is the Founder and President of Symbiosis – a multi-national, multi-lingual and multidisciplinary educational complex of repute. A distinguished academician and educationist, he is also the Chancellor of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) (SIU).

Dr. Mujumdar had his school education at Gadhinglaj and college education at Kolhapur and Pune. In his Master's Degree (M.Sc.) in Botany, he stood first class first with distinction in Pune University. He obtained his Doctorate (Ph.D.) in Microbiology from Pune University. He joined Fergusson College, Pune as Professor and Head of Department of Botany which position he held for 20 years. He was a member of the Pune University's Executive Council, the Senate, Academic Council and Chairman of the Board of Studies in Botany.

Deeply touched by the hardships suffered by the foreign students - especially Afro Asian students - studying in Pune, he established in 1971 'SYMBIOSIS' with a view to help them and provide them a 'Home away from Home'. He soon realized that education is the best medium for promoting international understanding. He, therefore, started establishing educational institutions imparting quality instruction in diverse disciplines.

Dr. Mujumdar is the recipient of many awards / honors. The Government of India has conferred on him 'Padma Shri' in 2005 and 'Padma Bhushan' in 2012. Tilak Maharashtra Vidhyapeeth has conferred on him 'D. Litt.' in 2016. He is recipient of first 'Dr. APJ Abdul kalam Memorial Award' in 2016. He has received Punya Bhushan Award (2009).

The year 2021-2022 was a very historic year for Symbiosis. On 6th March 2022, Symbiosis celebrated the commemoration of its Golden Jubilee and we were honored to have the **Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji who graced the momentous occasion and also inaugurated 'Symbiosis Aarogya Dham'**. This Symbiosis Arogya Dham built over 70 acres includes the Symbiosis Medical College for Women, Symbiosis University Hospital & Research Centre and institutes under the Faculty of Health Sciences. He also inaugurated the 'Symbiosis Rural Mobile Medical Van' and 'Symbiosis Rural Mobile Digital Literacy Lab' and the 'Symbiosis Suvarna Mahotsav Dwar'.

To continue the journey towards excellence, Symbiosis International (Deemed University) has excelled in various national and international rankings. The University has been ranked at no. 32 amongst the Universities in India by National Institute Ranking Framework (NIRF). Symbiosis Institute of Business Management (SIBM), Pune has been ranked at number 17 and Symbiosis Law School (SLS), Pune has been ranked at number 3. SIU has also been ranked #10 in Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievement (ARIIA) 2021.

In the international rankings, SIU has been ranked between 301-350 universities in Asia by the QS World Ranking Agency and SIU has been ranked among the top 251-300 Universities in Asia and between 800-1000 globally in the World Times Higher Education ranking Agency. Also, in THE Impact Universities Rankings, SIU has been ranked between 301-400 globally and 10th in India overall. Under SDGs, 54th globally and 2nd India in 'Responsible Consumption and Production', between 201-300 globally and 11th in India in 'Gender Equality', between 301-400 globally and 11th in India in 'Good Health and Well-being' and between 301-400 globally and 12th India in 'Partnership for the Goals'.

The new additions to the Symbiosis family in the year 2021-22 are Symbiosis Institute of Technology (SIT), Nagpur, Symbiosis Centre for Management Studies (SCMS), Bangalore, and Symbiosis Centre for Management Studies (SCMS) Hyderabad.

SIU also established Centres in specialised areas such as Symbiosis Centre for India Australia Studies (SCIAS), Symbiosis Centre for Research on International Higher Education (SCRIHE), Symbiosis Centre for Urban Studies (SCUS) and Symbiosis Centre for Climate Change and Sustainability (SCCCS).

The 18th Convocation Ceremony of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) was held on December 20th, 2021. Shri Bhagat Singh Koshyari, Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra was Chief Guest and Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, Hon'ble Minister for Education, Govt. of India was the Guest of Honour.

SIU hosted a roundtable on 'National Education Policy 2020- Transforming Vision into Practice' on 28th May 2022 at Symbiosis International University Campus, Lavale, Pune. Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, Hon'ble Minister of Education, Government of India graced the roundtable and delivered a keynote address on 'National Education Policy- Transforming Vision into Practice'. He also released the 'SIU NEP 2020 implementation report'. Eminent Educationists, University Leaders / Authorities, Vice Chancellors, Directors, Principals and faculty from various universities, colleges, and institutions across Maharashtra participated in this roundtable.

SIU is in the process of establishing a Health Science Technology Park (HSTP), a unique ecosystem for collaboration between Symbiosis University Hospital and Research Centre, specialised research centres, Symbiosis Institute of Technology and Symbiosis Centre for Entrepreneurship and Innovation (SCEI) which is the incubation Centre. The HSTP will also make provision for other Health-tech companies to be set up in the vicinity, to give students an opportunity to work on live projects and internships and the hospital will also provide synergy for the existing research centres.

Symbiosis is on an accelerated growth path. Towards this, we acknowledge the contribution of each and every stakeholder in the success of Symbiosis.

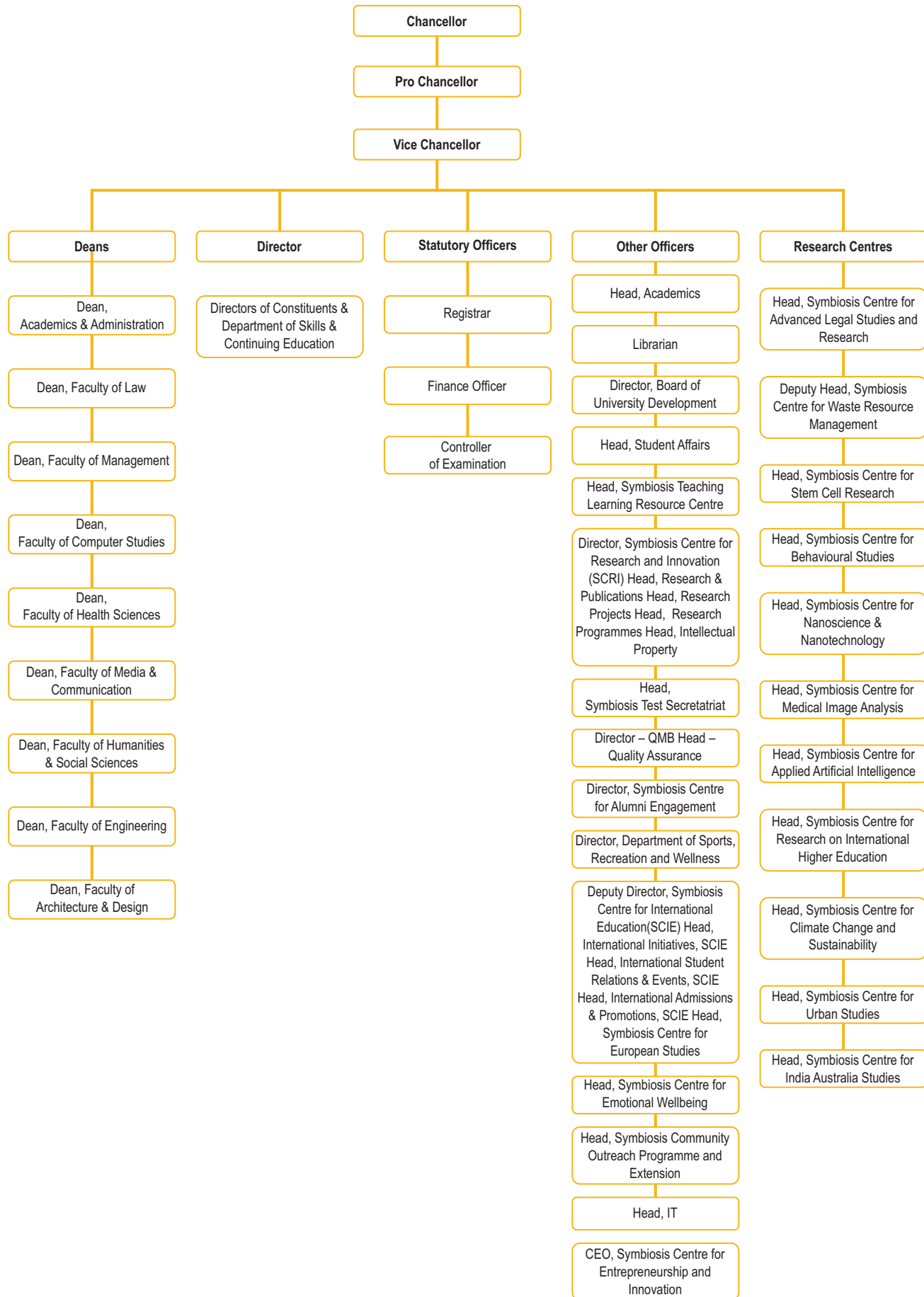

Admissions:

The University conducts all India-level entrance examinations for students who wish to pursue Doctoral, Post Graduate, and Under Graduate programmes offered by the University.

Candidates aspiring to join the MBA programme offered by constituents of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) have to appear for the common, mandatory Symbiosis National Aptitude (SNAP) Test in the month of December and January. For admission to the MBA programmes for AY 2021-22, SNAP 2020 was conducted as a Computer Based Test (CBT) across various cities of India in the months of December 2020 and January 2021. SNAP 2020 was conducted thrice for the academic year 2021-2022. A candidate was able to appear for a maximum of two tests for SNAP 2020.

Candidates aspiring to join B. ALL.B./ B.B. ALL. B / BCA/ BBA(IT)/ B.A. (M.C)/ B. Sc (Economics) Hons. / B.A. (Liberal Arts)/ B. Sc (Liberal Arts) / B. Sc (Culinary Arts) / B. Tech programmes offered by constituents of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) have to appear for the mandatory entrance tests. Since 2018, the SET - Law test is known as Symbiosis Law Admission Test (SLAT), SET - Design test, Symbiosis Entrance Exam for Design (SEED), SET - Engineering as Symbiosis Institute of Technology Engineering Entrance Exam (SITEEE) and SET - General as SET.

For pursuing a doctoral programme at the University, candidates have to appear for the Ph.D. Entrance test (PET) examinations. SET/SLAT/SITEEE/SEED & PET for admission to UG & Doctoral programmes in the academic year 2021-2022 were conducted in June 2021 through Online Home-Based Proctored mode. This was done keeping the safety & security of the candidates in mind.

Examination and Evaluation:

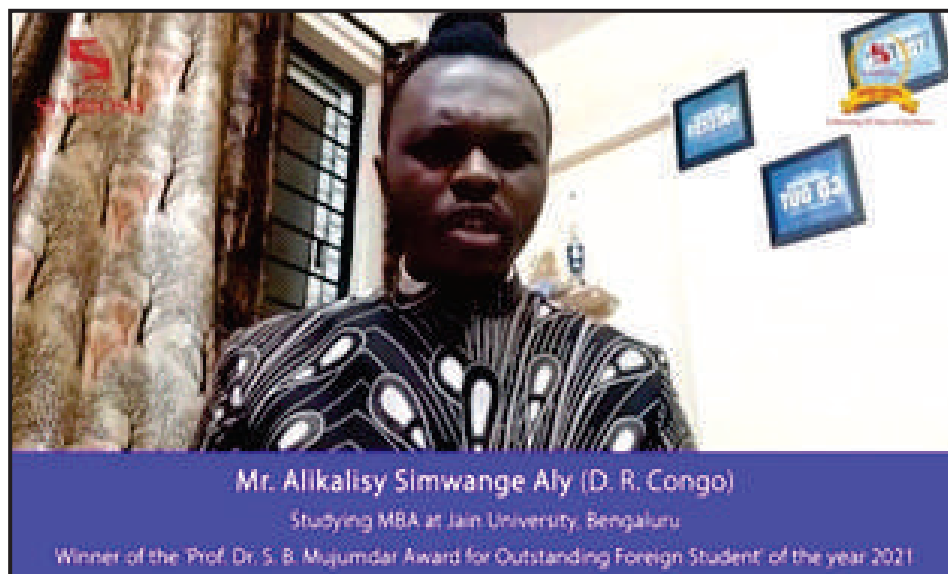

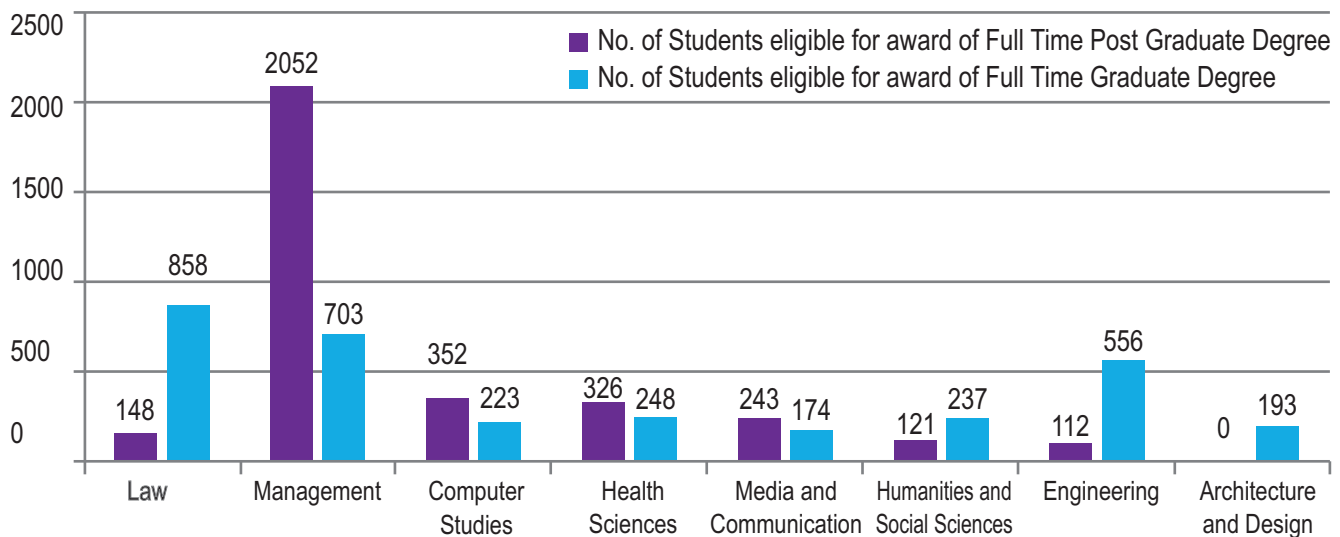

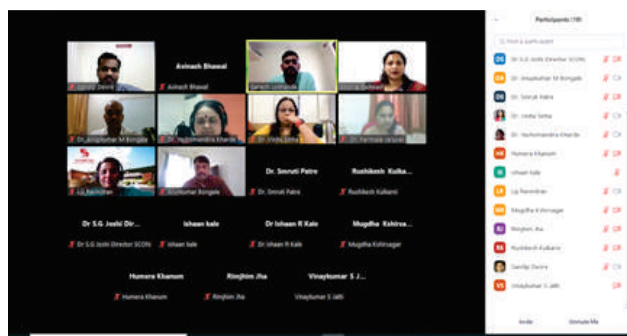

Research

The University has established the Symbiosis Centre for Research and Innovation (SCRI), which is a dedicated department for promoting and facilitating research among students and faculty. Through its academic and administrative services, SCRI enables researchers to achieve excellence in their work, and eventually, translates SIU's vision of creation of knowledge for the benefit of the Society into reality. The University has established several Research centres led by the researchers of repute in respective disciplines.

Research Centres:

Symbiosis Centre for Nanoscience and Nanotechnology (SCNN)

Symbiosis Centre for Nanoscience and Nanotechnology has been established in Sept. 2017 considering the potential impact of Nanoscience and Nanotechnology on evolution of Science, technology and societal growth. The Centre envisages promoting basic and applied research in the fields of healthcare, technology and environment, with primary impetus to fulfill national strategic needs. The major ventures of the centre are synthesis of advanced functional nano-materials, fabrication of nano-micro-devices, & its multidisciplinary applications. The major thrust of centre includes opportunities for international research collaborations; conduction of seminars/ workshops/ conferences/ extension lectures to promote Nanoscience & Nanotechnology to common people and to bridge the gap between nanotechnology research and its social acceptance.

Symbiosis Centre for Stem Cell Research (SCSCR)

The centre is unique, as it is the only research centre in Pune that will perform research exclusively on stem cells. Research in Experimental Hematology at a cellular and molecular level will be carried out with respect to aging of stem cells, microenvironment – mediated regulation of hematopoietic stem cells, leukemia/lymphoma biology, development of 3D cultures, mesenchymal stem cell biology with special focus on exosomes and micro-vesicles and signal transduction. Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Ministry of Science & Technology, Government of India has identified Stem Cell Research as one of the most exciting fields of life science in view of its potential clinical applications. With this understanding Symbiosis Centre for Stem Cell Research will serve in strengthening research in one of the targeted areas as identified by DBT's Medical Biotechnology programme.

Symbiosis Centre for Behavioural Studies (SCBS)

Keeping in mind that experimental research methods have a rich academic tradition both in psychology and marketing, Symbiosis Centre for Behavioural Studies has been established with aim to conduct experimental research in order to publish quality research papers in reputed journals. Its allied agenda of providing consultancy to organizations has also been kept in mind while marshaling the centre amongst industry and academia.

Symbiosis Centre for Waste Resource Management (SCWRM)

Symbiosis International (Deemed University) in the year 2015, established Symbiosis Centre for Waste Resource Management (SCWRM) to be a pioneer in building knowledge, disseminating awareness and improving practices in the area of sustainable waste management. The centre promotes inter and multi-disciplinary approach for basic and need-based, applied research and efforts in bridging the gap between lab and society with respect to solid and liquid waste management. The centre is involved in conducting workshops, training, and awareness programs to promote national agenda of 'Swachh Bharat Mission. The centre also works towards developing academic curriculum for undergraduate and post graduate courses. Furthermore, SCWRM is committed to interdisciplinary approach to develop insights, build awareness, and seek to identify, analyze, and implement key issues and challenges pertaining to waste management and sustainability involving all levels of stakeholder's viz. Government, statutory bodies, policy makers, corporates, academia, research institutes, civil society and many others. A key activity of SCWRM involves providing professional technical consultancy to various stakeholders in the field of solid waste management. SCWRM has consultancy projects with Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC), APMC Mumbai, Lonavala Municipal Corporation etc. on diverse aspects of municipal waste management. The centre is also an empaneled technical agency with the Government of Maharashtra to implement the national GOBAR-DHAN scheme in Maharashtra state at district levels under Swachh Bharat Mission (G)-II. The centre has several national and international collaborations to develop a network of researchers across the globe to address the issue of waste management and climate change.

Symbiosis Centre for Medical Image Analysis (SCMIA)

In recent years there has been an increased thrust to understand and quantify the complex information conveyed by medical images. Developing modern computational techniques that offer the potential for extracting diverse and complex information from imaging data and applying the setoaplethora of clinical studies is crucial. These techniques not only support precise quantification but also overcome the limitations of subjective visual interpretation. Furthermore, these methods can facilitate finding specific markers that relate to pathologies as well as aid in treatment planning. Building on this background, the objectives of this center are as follows:

- Development of novel computer-based image analysis methods and their application to a wide variety of clinical research studies
- Translating the techniques to the clinic thereby aiding early diagnosis and understanding of the underlying pathology.

Currently, the center focuses on neuroimaging (MRI) and breast imaging (ultrasound). Image analysis methodologies include volumetric analysis, diffusion MRI processing and analysis, structural and functional connectomics, statistical learning in imaging, radiomics, population-based analysis and deep neural networks for image classification. In future, the center plans to diversify research to image analysis of various organs and include multiple modalities in imaging.

Symbiosis Centre for Applied Artificial Intelligence (SCAAI)

Symbiosis Centre for Applied AI (SCAAI) was established in May 2019 and is affiliated to Symbiosis Centre for Research and Innovation (SCRI). SCAAI is a constituent of Symbiosis International (Deemed University). The primary aim of this centre is to spearhead the advancement and novel developments in various application areas and promotion of the advanced research and education in the field of AI. Along with this SCAAI engages in interdisciplinary research to address pertinent issues that could involve a huge spectrum such as finance and banking to healthcare.

Symbiosis Centre for Advanced Legal Studies and Research (SCALSAR)

Symbiosis Centre for Advanced Legal Studies and Research organized in 2007 and formalized in February 2013 by the Board of Management, SIU. It SCALSAR was established to facilitate advanced legal studies and research. SCALSAR facilitates and provides:

- The means including idea architecture and resources for advanced legal studies for post graduate, including LLM students and PhD Students.
- Infrastructure and resources for advanced legal research to the faculty, researchers and post graduate students promoting and facilitating publications in SCOPUS, Web of Science and UGC recognised journals
- To collaborate with institutes under the faculty and departments within SIU, National and International Universities and Agencies for research, consultation, training and extension
- Research, training and consultancy in selected areas of 4 excellence centres aligned with SIU clusters, other research centres and contemporary areas of national and global importance
- Interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary studies and research while interlinking with SIU research clusters
- To act as a think-tank to the Government, hosts Scholars in residence, undertake interdisciplinary legal studies and research projects, train teachers and design training modules.
- Collaboration with institutes under the faculty and departments within SIU, National and International Universities and Agencies for research, consultation, training and extension
- To disseminate and ensure the outcome of research, training, advocacy and consultation to stakeholders including businesses, law makers, government and non-governmental entities, people of India and the world
- Positive and measurable impact on the society and justice system through inclusive research and training

Symbiosis Center for Urban Studies (SCUS)

The Centre will be operational from the AY 2022-23, and will undertake activities to focus on Capacity Building, and being responsible for creating human capital to help transform India's urban landscape.

Research activities of the Centre will include:

- Organizing Guest Lectures Workshop, Seminars, Symposiums, Conferences, Hackathon.
- Strengthen the PhD Department under this specialization
- Collaborative Inter-disciplinary Research with our sister institutions
- To provide excellent opportunities to collaborate with supranational institutions and urban diplomacy
- To collaborate with leading think tanks and organizations supporting the Indian urban agenda

Symbiosis Center for Climate Change and Sustainability (SCCCS)

The SCCC is established with the following proposed activities:

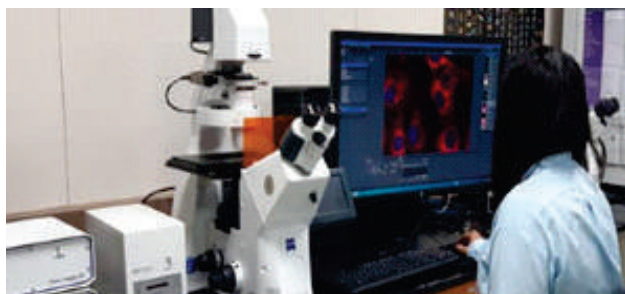
- Collaborative Research in thematic areas
- PhD program, post-doctoral research
- Education by developing courses in Climate Change for UG & PG institutions
- Social Outreach by conducting Workshops, lectures, taking up Restoration projects, Park / Devrai conservation.

Symbiosis Center for Research on International Higher Education (SCRIHE)

SCRIHE is established for conducting research in the area of international higher education. The NEP 2020 has earmarked a whole chapter on Internationalization of Higher Education. With the COVID pandemic, there have been different challenges that higher education faced, but one positive outcome has been internationalization at home. Collaborative online international learning, co-teaching and co-learning have been promoted due to online education. New concepts of international co-operation and intra- regional cooperation have emerged which enhance the internationalization of Higher Education. Knowledge diplomacy and how higher education can be a tool for development and soft power is also coming into discussion at the global level.

Symbiosis Centre for India Australia Studies (CIAS)

India-Australia relations are set to become stronger in recent times; Higher Education has always played a dominant role with a large student outflow from India. Both Countries have introduced initiatives like Colombo Plan, Scheme for Promotion of Academic and Research Collaboration (SPARC), Australia-India Strategic Research Fund (AISRF). In order to further enhance these relations and open up new avenues for Academic initiatives with Australian Universities and to foster Academia-industry relations with focus on SDGs will be the main motive behind setting up of the Symbiosis Centre for India Australia Studies (CIAS). It will act as an overarching umbrella for all activities involving students and faculty where they can share ideas across disciplines and sectors.



Laboratory

Research Publications

The University has focused and made consistent efforts in the last 9-10 years to encourage the faculty members to undertake research and publish the same in good scholarly journals indexed in Scopus and Web of Science. As a result, the number of publications indexed in Scopus has increased substantially from 25 in 2010-11 to 4391 publications as of 31st July 2022.

In the AY 2021-22, a total of 887 and 616 research papers were published in top journals indexed in Scopus and Web of Science (SCI, SCIE, SSCI, AHCI, ESCI), respectively, as shown in the table. Over a period of time, the number of citations, h-index, i10-index and average citations per publications of SIU research publications are also increasing exponentially thereby indicating that quality depicts the number of publications in Scopus and Web of Science in last 5 years. In 2019-20, 456 papers were published in Q1 and Q2 category Scopus/WoS journals.

As regards to intellectual property, the university has filed 21 national and international patents till date, and out of which 14 patents are published.

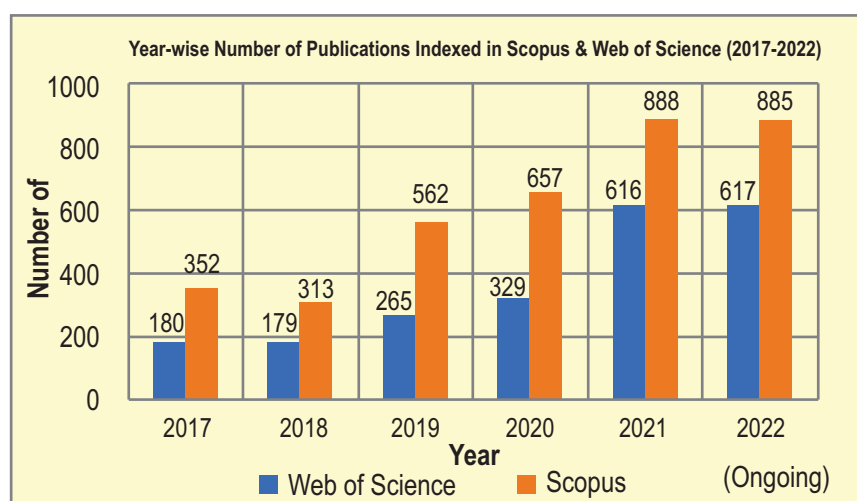

Orientation Program:

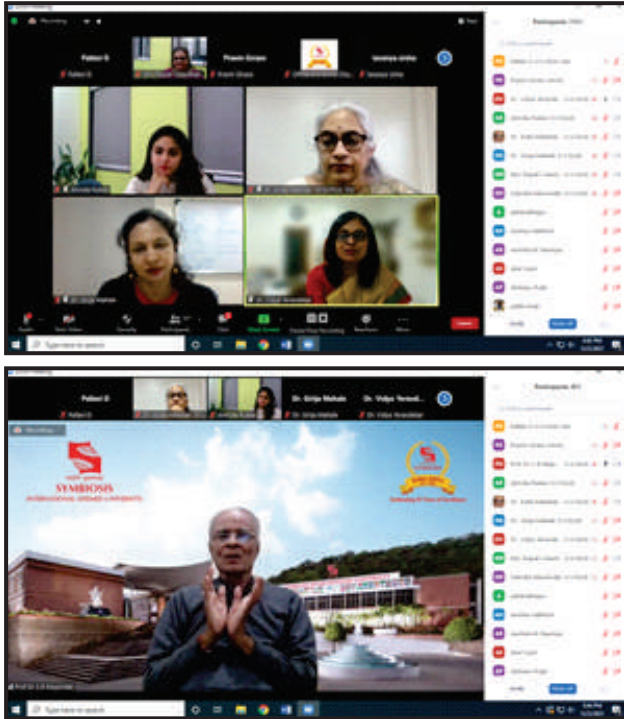

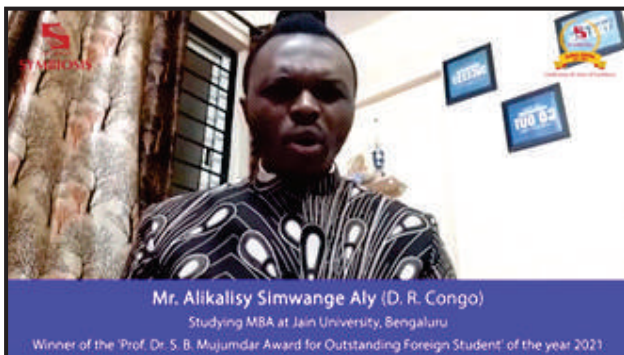


'Prof. (Dr.) S. B. Mujumdar Award for The Outstanding Foreign Student Of The Year' (2020)

Semester (Outgoing): Under GIP, SIU students undertake a semester at our partner Universities and can get credit transfers for the courses undertaken at Partner universities. 51 students participated in Semester Exchange and abroad at partner universities in Germany, France, UK, and Australia.

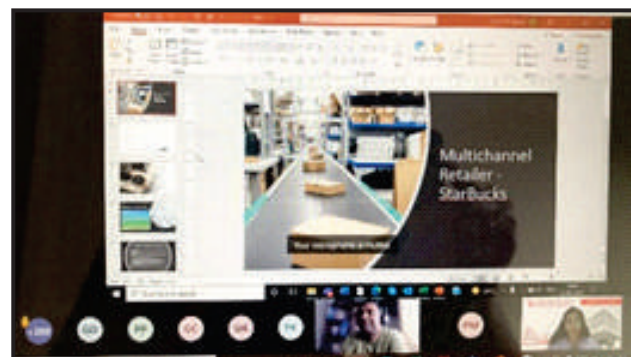
Design Thinking was also conducted by Professors from both Universities.



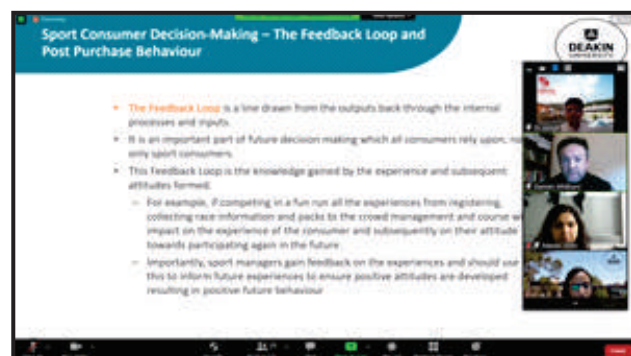
FACULTY PROGRAMS:

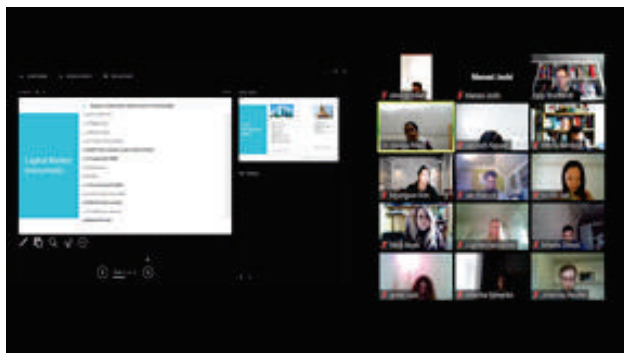

Outgoing Faculty

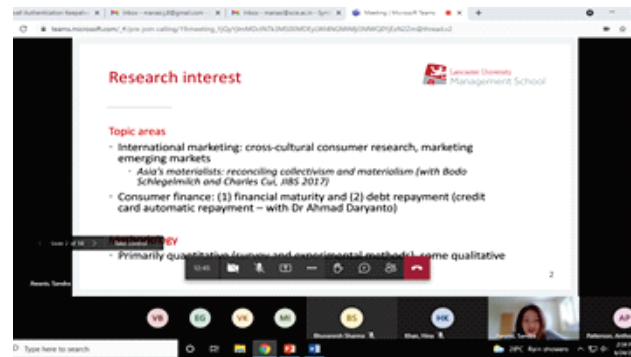

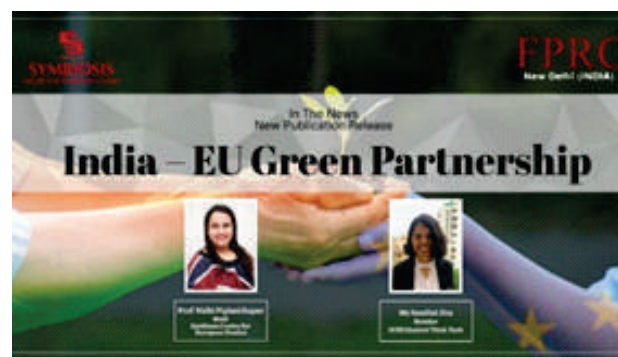

E-Cook Book by Indian & International Students 'The World Kitchen'

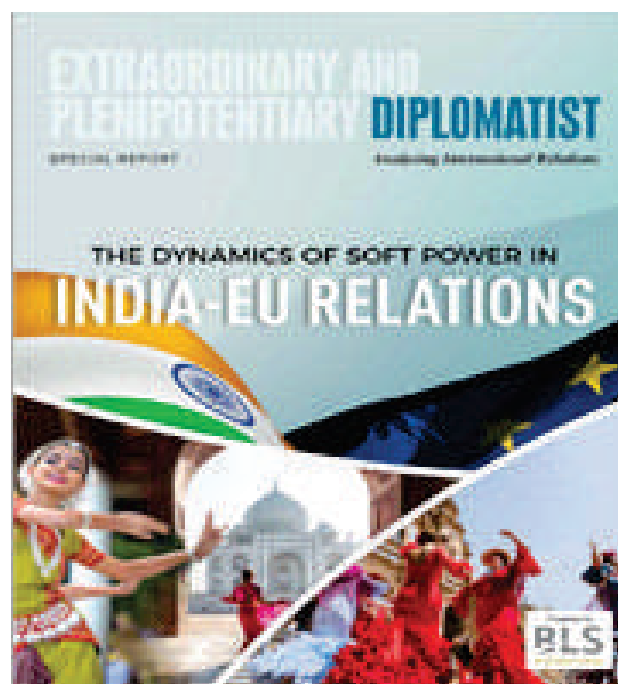

Symbiosis Centre for India Australia Studies (SCIAS)

In order to further enhance these relations and open up new avenues for Academic initiatives with Australian Universities and to foster Academia-industry relations with focus on SDGs will be the main motive behind setting up of the Symbiosis Centre for India Australia Studies (SCIAS). It will act as an overarching umbrella for all activities involving students and faculty where they can share ideas across disciplines and sectors. SCIAS was officially launched by Mr Peter Truswell, Consul-General for Australia in Mumbai and Dr Vidya Yeravdekar Pro-Chancellor, SIU.



The activities envisaged under the Centre will include mobility of students, developing pathway programs, encourage mobility of Faculty, research scholars for building connections/networking leading to conducting joint research, Cotutelle Programs, offering electives to students to learn Literature, History, Society, Culture, Art, Politics, Indigenous studies.

Symbiosis International University (SIU)-Australia Connect:

Symbiosis has collaborations with Universities like Deakin, Macquarie, University of Queensland, Bond, University of Adelaide and University of Melbourne for study abroad programs, hosting Joint Conferences, webinars, Faculty exchange and Summer Schools in fields of Finance and Media.

SIU also has a research Project under SPARC- an initiative launched by the MHRD, Govt. of India for conducting research in entrepreneurship especially for women with Deakin University. Deakin and Symbiosis have launched Women Entrepreneurship Research Alliance (WERA).

Physical & Emotional Wellbeing:

Sports and Games are essential components of human resource development, helping to promote good health, comradeship and spirit of healthy competition which in turn has positive impact on holistic development of personality of the Youth who are the potential source of energy, enthusiasm and inspiration for development, progress and prosperity of a Nation. ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED:

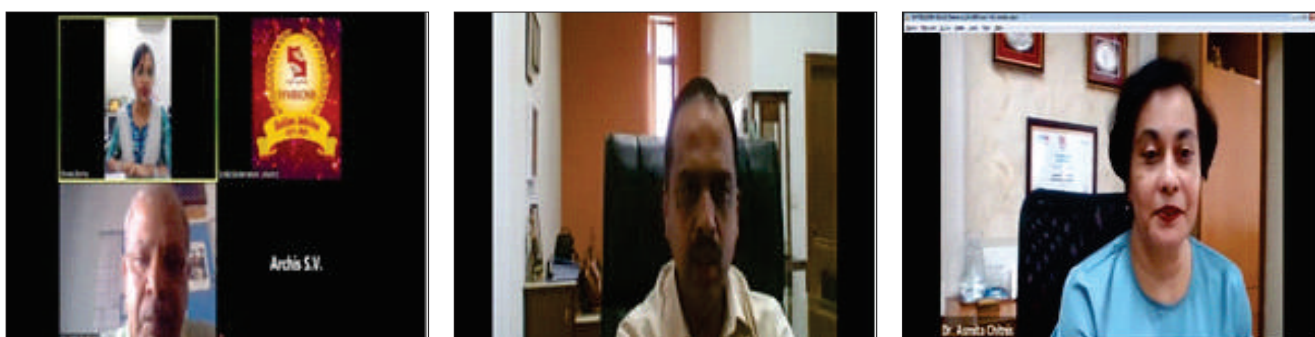

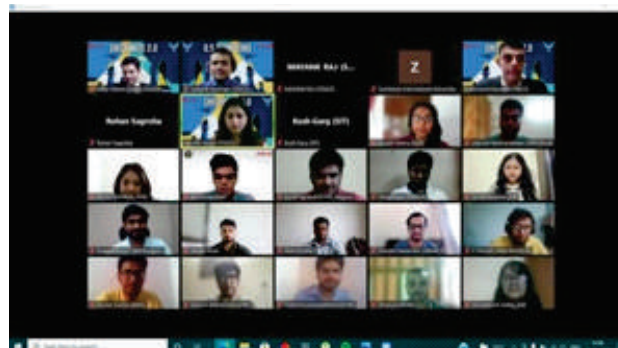

Innovative Activities:

(7 hours Sleep Challenge / 8 Glasses of Water Challenge / Cycle to Work Challenge / daily monitoring resting heart rate to enable DSRW to devise interventions to improve fitness and promote healthy habits among staff).

Yoga Pop ups -The concept involves promoting the practice of Yoga through Pop-Ups which would display on every employee's desktop at a specified time throughout the day -4 times a day in all campuses.

75 Crore Surya Namaskar project: The Department of Sports, Recreation & Wellness, Symbiosis International (Deemed University) conducted a 21-days Surya Namaskar project proposed by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, wherein we offered virtual Yoga sessions for Suryanamaskar practice to the students, staff and their friends and family. The Surya Namaskar project countdown program started on the 24th January, 2022 and concluded on the 18th of February, 2022. Live yoga sessions were conducted twice on all the days (morning and evening) with focus on the practice of Suryanamaskar. The classes were conducted by trained DSRW experts and received tremendous response with participants' numbers ranging from 50 to 180 in every session. Since the sessions were conducted virtually, sessions saw participation from the family members too. Total participation in the event was 1525 in 42 sessions.

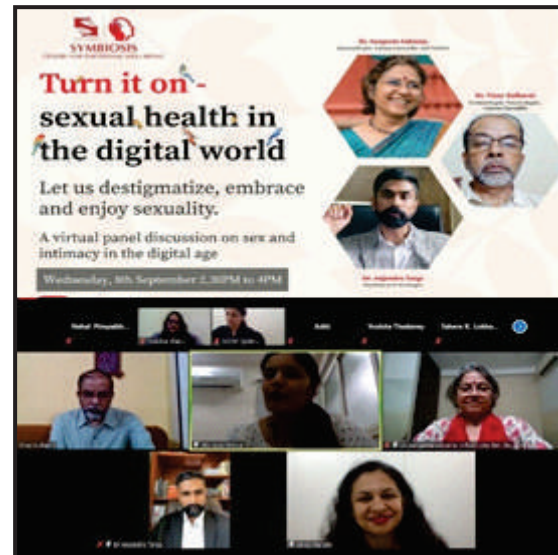

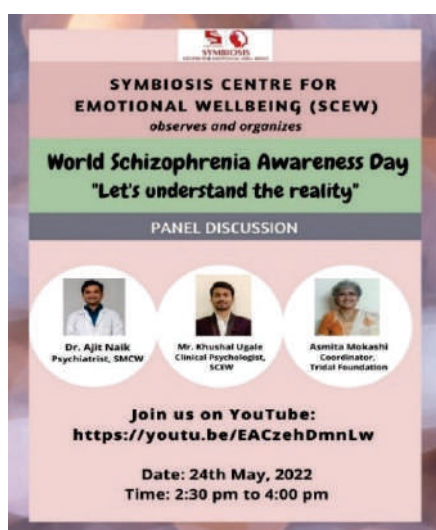

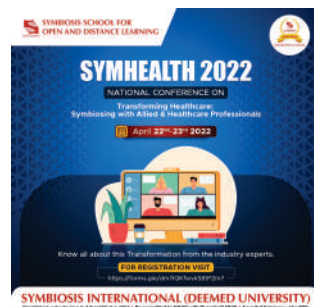
Symbiosis Literary Fest 2021:

SYMCHARCHA 2022:

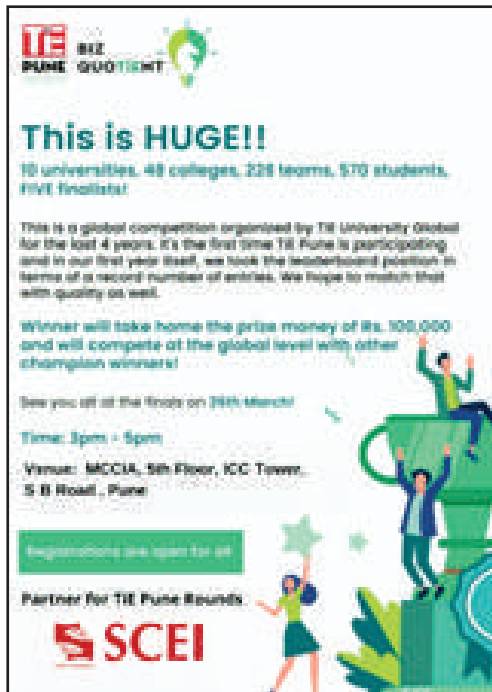

Science day:

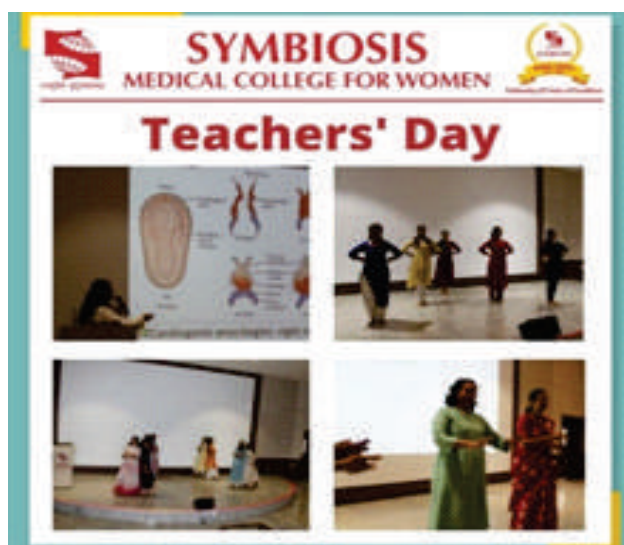

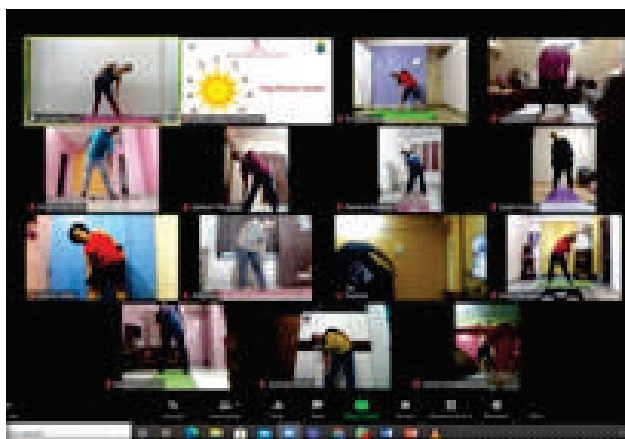


Tree plantation drive organised by SCWRM.

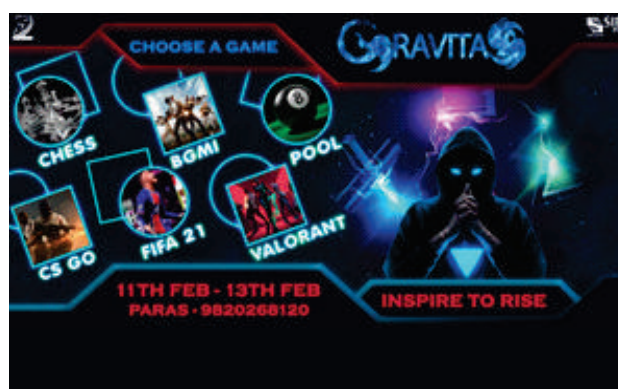

The objective was to help them become self-sufficient and gain financial independence by monetising their passion and skills.

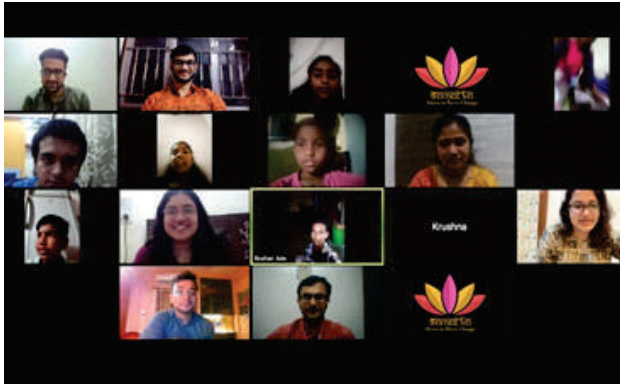

The 10-week long weekend course trains them in conversational English, communication skills, general etiquette, telephone and email etiquette, GD & PI skills, public speaking and presentation skills. 42 batches have been conducted so far.

Books and clothes donations (Donation Drive): The drive was initiated on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Prof. S.B. Mujumdar, Founder and President of Symbiosis International (Deemed) University, and International Students Day. Faculty members, staff and students of Symbiosis Centre of Management Studies NOIDA donated more than 300 books and clothes which were further handed over to NGOs - Robinhood Army (for Clothes Donation) and Vrikshit Foundation (for Books Donation). Symbiosis Law School, Pune also donated 417 books to Daulatrao Jadhav Prison Officers Training College, Yerawada, Pune on 08 October 2021.

National Seminar on "Identification of Abusive Relationship and Prevention of Domestic Violence": To spread awareness regarding domestic violence Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur organized a National Seminar on "Identification of Abusive Relationship and Prevention of Domestic Violence" in collaboration with **National Commission for Women (NCW), New Delhi** on 8th March, 2022.

It conducted 5 Awareness sessions and 30 General Health check-up camps and 1 Multispecialty check-up camp in the Academic Year 2021-22 with 3788 beneficiaries. Additionally, SCOPE team was also involved in VHND (Village Health & Nutrition Day) with PHC Mutha since Dec 2021. SCOPE Healthcare team collaborated with internal and external stakeholders for mega activities of Health Check up camp at Bhima Koregaon on 1st January, 2022 (Beneficiaries – 1120) and Pulse Polio drive in February 2022 at Susgaon, Mahalunge and Nande villages (Beneficiaries – 228). Students of SIHS, SCON and SMCW actively took part in various outreach programs of SCOPE like Health Check up camps, Ante natal camps, Diet and Nutrition, Glaucoma, TB, Smoking, Breast feeding, Menstrual Hygiene, COVID-19 care, HIV, Rabies amongst others. The students also participated actively in the Medical services offered during the Wari pilgrim festival.

Covid Care: Responding to the COVID-19 pandemic, the SCOPE team conceptualized, designed, and delivered a Certificate course in COVID-19 Care for Community as a MOOC in English, Hindi, and Marathi. Over 1000 individuals enrolled in the program from across the nation. Additionally, the team collaborated with various institutes to provide aid and support towards renting their social responsibility initiatives. Despite the restrictions due to the COVID-19 pandemic, over 200 students from multiple institutes volunteered to conduct various awareness sessions and activities in the villages identified by the university. During the COVID Pandemic, Hospitals across the country were running out of oxygen supplies, ventilators, and beds. The social club of Symbiosis Institute of Technology (SIT), Pune the V@rSITy Care started helping in this COVID situation by

verifying leads and helping people to reach resources for COVID through Instagram and WhatsApp groups. The team comprising of students and faculties of SIT, Pune were working 15-20 hours a day, helping over 300 people. Slowly people across India joined hands with this initiative and could reach people even outside the campus for this noble cause.

Free Health Services to the needy: The Symbiosis University Hospital and Research Centre (SUHRC) has been providing comprehensive tertiary care services through its state-of-the-art infrastructure, equipment and highly trained fulltime health care work force. Since January of 2021, the General or Teaching Wing of the hospital has been providing all services totally free of cost, thanks to the vision and generosity of our Hon'ble Chancellor. A total of: 337875 OPD patients and 17367 admitted patients have benefitted from the free services. Oncology (cancer) has also been added to the spectrum of specialties and SUHRC has been providing surgical and chemotherapeutic services to all patients, specially the underprivileged and underserved. Close to 6000 COVID patients were treated with very good results and a low death rate, amongst the best outcomes in the city and the state. SUHRC continued the vaccination drive all through 2021 and half of 2022, in the process delivering over 1.2 lac doses to beneficiaries.

Special Olympics Bharath Health screening Campaign: The Nutrition and Dietetics students of Symbiosis Institute of Health Sciences (SIHS) participated in Special Olympics Bharath Health screening Campaign at Ganesh Khind, Pune, Rainbow Campaign for the promotion of fruits and vegetable consumption, Healthy Millet Challenge-essay writing contest, Community needs assessment and nutrition education programme at Rihe village and the nutrition awareness programme.

Non- Healthcare Initiatives:

The Non-healthcare initiative ensured the villages adopt good sanitation and waste management practices under the domain of waste management. Under Service Learning, from June 2021 to May 2022 students from ten different institutes completed the Service Learning credit course by investing 234960 human hours in community service while working on a variety of projects in both rural and urban settings.

This year SCOPE collaborated with 89 NGOs to implement the activities like creating a documentary on water, spreading awareness about the Government health scheme (MJPJY), and spreading awareness about water-borne diseases and preventive methods. Service Learning students worked on different aspects of social issues like environment preservation, health awareness, providing education to underprivileged children, and documentaries (on waste management, river pollution, water problem, etc.). The University has launched the Digital Literacy Van which goes to different villages and provide computer education to the children in the remote villages. 272 learners from 9 different villages enrolled for the Digital Literacy.
