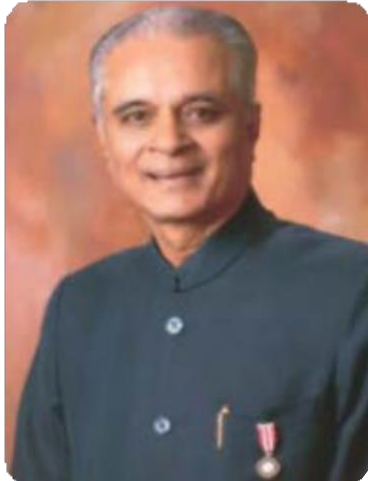

Dr. S. B. Mujumdar is the Founder and President of Symbiosis – a multi-national, multi-lingual and multidisciplinary educational complex of repute. A distinguished academician, and educationist, he is also the Chancellor of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) (SIU).

Dr. Mujumdar was born on 31st July, 1935 at Gadhinglaj, a Taluka in Kolhapur District in Maharashtra. He had his school education at Gadhinglaj and college education at Kolhapur and Pune. In his Master's Degree (M.Sc.) in Botany, he stood first class first with distinction in Pune University. He obtained his Doctorate (Ph.D.) in Microbiology from Pune University.

He joined Fergusson College, Pune, as Professor and Head of Department in Botany, a position which he held for 20 years. He was a recognized Postgraduate teacher and a guide for Ph.D. students. He was a member of the Pune University's Executive Council, the Senate, Academic Council (for 14 years) and Chairman of the Board of Studies in Botany (for 9 years). He was also I.C.C.R's Foreign Academic Advisor in Pune University (for 7 years).

He has published over 50 original research articles in several national and international scientific journals. He has authored several books on Life Sciences and has contributed over 200 articles on Science, Education and Youth Development. He has also been the Chairman of the Educational Wing of FICCI in 2005-2006.

Deeply touched by the hardships suffered by the foreign students - especially Afro Asian students - studying in Pune, he established in 1971 'SYMBIOSIS' with a view to help them and provide them a 'Home away from Home'. He soon realized that education is the best medium for promoting international understanding. He, therefore, established educational institutions imparting quality education in diverse disciplines e.g. Management, Law, IT, Computer Studies, Health and Biomedical Sciences, Engineering, International Business, Geo-Informatics, Media and Communication, Photography etc.

Thus, Symbiosis was established with the motto of 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam' - meaning the world is one family'. The two ideals of Gurudev Rabindranath Tagore's 'Vishwa Bharati' and Sane Guruji's 'Antar Bharati' are adopted as Symbiosis' guiding principles. Presently, Symbiosis has 46 institutions and about 32,000 students from all States of India and 85 foreign countries. In 2002, the Ministry of HRD, Government of India, conferred upon Symbiosis the status of 'Deemed to be University'. Many Symbiosis institutions are ranked amongst the top 10 institutions in India with a placement record of almost 100%. Realizing the importance of distance education, Symbiosis established Symbiosis Centre for Distance Learning (SCDL), which conducts a number of online courses with over 2 lakh students from India as well as many foreign countries. One of the unique institutions established by Symbiosis is Symbiosis Institute of Management **Studies** (SIMS), for Defence Personnel and their dependents,

providing management education. Another innovative institution is the 'Pune Police Public School' managed by Symbiosis, which provides education to the children of Police Personnel.

Symbiosis houses two museums viz. Afro-Asian Cultural Museum and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Museum and Memorial which has collection of personal belongings and memorabilia of Dr. Ambedkar. Symbiosis has also established the 'Symbiosis Ishanya Cultural and Educational Centre (SICEC)' for cultural integration of North Eastern states with mainland India.

Dr. Mujumdar is the recipient of many awards / honors. The Government of India conferred on him 'Padma Shri' in 2005 and 'Padma Bhushan' in 2012. Tilak Maharashtra Vidhyapeeth conferred on him 'D. Litt.' in 2016. He is also the recipient of first 'Dr. APJ Abdul kalam Memorial Award' in 2016, and has been conferred with numerous awards such as Punya Bhushan Award (2009), FIE Foundation Puraskar (2006), 'Maharashtra Gaurav Puraskar' (2003), Top Management Club Pune's "Excellence in Education" Award, the Rotary Club of Pune's 'Service Excellence Recognition Award (SERA)', The Rotary Foundation of Rotary International Paul Harris Fellow, Giant International Life Time Achievement Award, Lion Gaurav Puraskar, Pune Municipal Corporation's 'Roll of Honour for Life-Time Achievement' (2006), Pune Festival Award and many others.

The year 2018-19 has also been an eventful year for the University. Our Chancellor Dr. Mujumdar Sir's mantra for Symbiosis is...

Excellence, Expansion, Equity

Excellence – Symbiosis Institutions have excelled this year too. The University has been ranked amongst the top Universities in India by National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2019. SIU has been ranked at number 56. SIBM, Pune has been ranked at number 20 and SLS, Pune has been ranked at number 7. The University is ranked amongst the top 280 Universities in Asia, 109 in BRICS and 23rd in India by QS Rankings Survey 2019. SIU also received the “Most Promising University (West)” award by Global India Education Forum at Geneva, Switzerland. SIU is the first University in Asia to be awarded The Asia-Pacific Quality Label (APQL) for 'Internationalization' for a period of five years.

Expansion – The new addition to the Symbiosis family is the Symbiosis International (Deemed University) Campus at Nagpur. A magnificent campus spread over 75 acres and designed by the famous architect Hafeez Contractor, the Nagpur Campus houses 4 institutes of Symbiosis viz. Symbiosis Institute of Business Management (SIBM), Symbiosis Law School (SLS), Symbiosis School of Planning, Architecture and Design (SSPAD) and Symbiosis Centre for Management Studies (SCMS). Architecture is a new discipline at SIU. The Noida Campus has also got a new 'avatar'. The Symbiosis Law School, Noida and Symbiosis Center for Management Studies, Noida have moved into a new Campus built on the remaining 5 acres of land at Noida. Additional residential facilities for students have also been created.

To promote internationalization further, a new centre has been established viz. the Symbiosis Centre for European Studies(SCES). This was inaugurated by Mr. Andrej Babiš Hon'ble Prime Minister of the Czech Republic. The Centre will be based on a three-fold mandate of teaching, training and outreach to foster progressive insights on EU integration, locally, nationally, and internationally. It will promote the interdisciplinary understanding of European languages, history, politics, economy and societies.

The Symbiosis International (Deemed University) is in the process of a setting up of the Symbiosis Medical College for Women (SMCW) under the Faculty of Health Sciences at SIU Campus, Lavale. A Multispecialty Hospital has been established to deliver quality patient care to the community in the neighboring area.

The Management Development Programs of Symbiosis are acknowledged and revered by renowned blue chip corporates both in India and abroad. Symbiosis, which always has a penchant for excellent infrastructure set up a dedicated Leadership Development Centre named 'Sandipani' at the Lavale Campus. This Centre has residential facilities to accommodate 150 participants and has a well-designed block of classrooms with contemporary amenities.

Equity – Symbiosis has always focused on inclusion and equity. Scholarships to the tune of Rs 12.36 crore have been given to Indian students and 32 international students have also been given scholarships. SIU has launched Dr. Anandi Gopal Scholarship Scheme. This scholarship will be awarded purely on merit and will be granted to the top 5 girls who qualify through NEET merit list of students who get selected and enrolled to the M.B.B.S. programme at Symbiosis Medical College for Women in the first year i.e. from 2020.

This mantra of 'EEE' has helped Symbiosis grow to further heights! We seek your blessings in this journey.

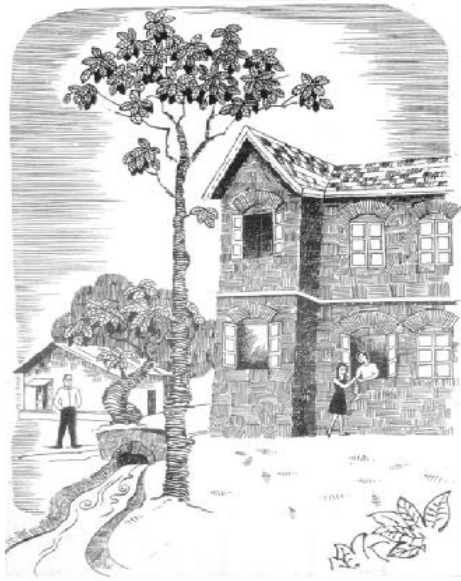

EXPANSION

The Nagpur Municipal Corporation has granted 75 acres of land to Symbiosis to establish a university campus with programmes in Management, Law, Architecture and Design, Architecture, etc.

Symbiosis International (Deemed University) also has plans to expand in the area of executive development programmes in India and overseas as a part of its extension activities.

EXCELLENCE

Symbiosis International (Deemed University) dreams of becoming a World Class University. It is striving hard to build innovative technologies in the teaching learning process, enhancing research, encouraging innovations and empowering students to become entrepreneurs.

Symbiosis International (Deemed University) has established Research Centres in various domains like Behavioural studies, Nano sciences and Nanotechnology, Medical Image Analysis, Stem Cell Research, Waste Resource Management, etc. and is in the process of constructing a 300 bedded hospital with a Centre for Health Skills on the Lavale campus. This will be a teaching and research hospital which will have an Emergency & Out Patient Departments (OPDs) for medicine, Nephrology, Gynaecology, Paediatric, Orthopaedic, Gastroenterology, ENT, Dental, Ophthalmology & Cardiac and cater to the people from the neighbouring villages. With the presence of Symbiosis Institute of Technology, Symbiosis School of Biological Sciences, Symbiosis School of Culinary Arts,

and Symbiosis Centre for Entrepreneurship and Innovation where startup companies are incubated, the whole area at the foothills of the University campus will be a Health Science Technology Park.

EQUITY

Symbiosis has always been sensitive to the needs of the underprivileged and has always engaged meaningfully with the local community. The University plans to increase the scholarship funds to help students from the weaker sections of society. Symbiosis International (Deemed University) also plans to increase the scholarships for students coming from developing countries.

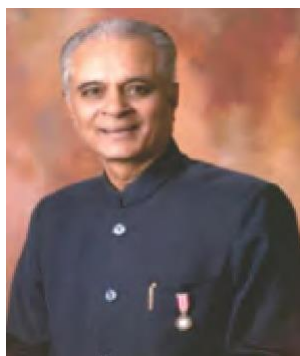

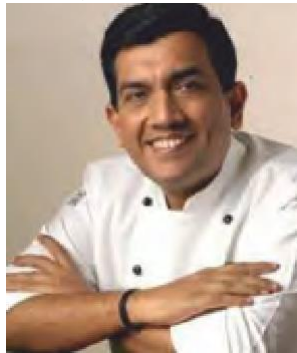

Overview



The main campus of the University is located in the picturesque hilly terrain spread over 350 acres of land adjacent to Lavale village near city of Pune. Symbiosis continues to evolve on 3 pillars viz. excellence, expansion, and equity. The University has 38 Constituent Institutions /Departments spread across five cities viz. Pune, Nashik, Bengaluru, NOIDA, and Hyderabad, and offers academic programmes under eight Faculties, namely Law, Management, Computer Studies, Health Sciences, Media & Communication, Humanities & Social Sciences, Engineering and Architecture & Design. The University has well qualified and dedicated faculty to impart education to its students. It has state-of-art infrastructural facilities with well-equipped classrooms and laboratories, and resourceful libraries. All campuses of the University have hostels for girls and boys with indoor and outdoor sports facilities and Health Care Centres. To ensure quality of academic programmes, choice-based credit system, experiential learning, strong industry-academic interface, the University has collaborated with eminent universities some of which are ranked in QS 500 World rankings. It is one of the few universities which have been selected to admit students under the 'Study in India' Program of the Government of India. The world-class infrastructural facilities and learning resources, with qualified and experienced faculty, dedicated support staff and almost 100% placements has made the University the most favoured destination for learners from all states of the country and from over 85 different countries. The industry too continues to endorse that the students are highly coveted as members of the international workforce well equipped with leadership qualities to serve the communities at different level. The University has established research centres in niche areas and is receiving funds for various research projects. Today more than 17,000 students pursue their aspirations and dreams via doctoral, postgraduate and undergraduate education in diverse disciplines at Symbiosis International (Deemed University).

Furthermore, the University has been awarded the Category-I status by the University Grants Commission. By virtue of the Category-I University, University Grants Commission has also given 12 B status to the University. It has also been ranked number 1 in the country by MHRD in the Swachh Campus Rankings 2019, and ranked 56th in Universities Category by the National Institutional Ranking Framework 2019. SIU has embarked on a number of new initiatives which include augmentation of labs, classrooms, student support facilities, library, IT resources and campus facilities. The University has excellent sports facilities in its campuses for outdoor and indoor games such as Basketball, Football, Volley ball, Cricket, Badminton, Table tennis, Squash, Swimming Pool, Chess, Carrom and Gymnasiums.

The Wi-Fi enabled state-of-the-art infrastructure at all campuses of the University include well-furnished classrooms with multimedia facility, well-equipped laboratories, faculty cabins, well stacked libraries, seminar halls, auditoria, food courts, common rooms and hostels, rest rooms for students and staff, facilities for indoor and outdoor games, recreation and wellness facilities, and health centres.

Shuttle buses are provided at all locations of Symbiosis for students. Facilities such as banking, stationary stores, laundry services, photocopy centre, are also available for students.

The library resources comprising of books and e-resources are complementary to the teaching-learning process. Wi-Fi campuses enable 24/7 usage of e-resources, thus adding to the flexibility of students to study at their pace and time. Libraries also provide value added services to faculty members, for research activities.

SYMBIOSIS COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAM & EXTENSION (SCOPE)

Symbiosis International (Deemed University) (SIU) launched Symbiosis Community Outreach Programme and Extension (SCOPE) activities on 2nd July 2012 with the objective of positively impacting the community around SIU. SCOPE initiative through its twin arms of healthcare initiatives and non-health initiatives is working towards a comprehensive and holistic development of the 23 identified villages located in Mulshi taluka. In addition to various community outreach initiatives, SCOPE also manages the service learning of the curriculum at SIU and engages in multiple research projects that are aimed at understanding the society and various challenges faced by the society.

Healthcare initiatives

The healthcare initiative currently operates two Family Doctor Clinics (FDC), located at Sus and Nande village, and one Mobile Medical Unit (MMU). The FDC and MMU together over the past few years have reached out to provide preventive, curative and promotive healthcare services to more than 76000 individuals in the past year. The health care services are targeted at beneficiaries who are residents of rural areas, thus are poor, needy and marginalised population residing in access compromised areas. In addition to healthcare service, the healthcare arm of SCOPE is also involved in research activities, and conducts numerous awareness generation activities.

Non Healthcare activities

SCOPE through its non healthcare activities works with various stakeholders in the identified villages to work in the areas of Education, Livelihoods, Sanitation and Waste Management, Financial Inclusion etc. In order to implement the various projects, SCOPE collaborates with various institutes of SIU.

Service learning

Service Learning is one of the components offered to under graduate students under Floating Credits Program. The course is of 4 credits and students have to put in 60 hours of community service related to their academic discipline. Through service learning, students learn how service makes a difference in them and in the lives of others.

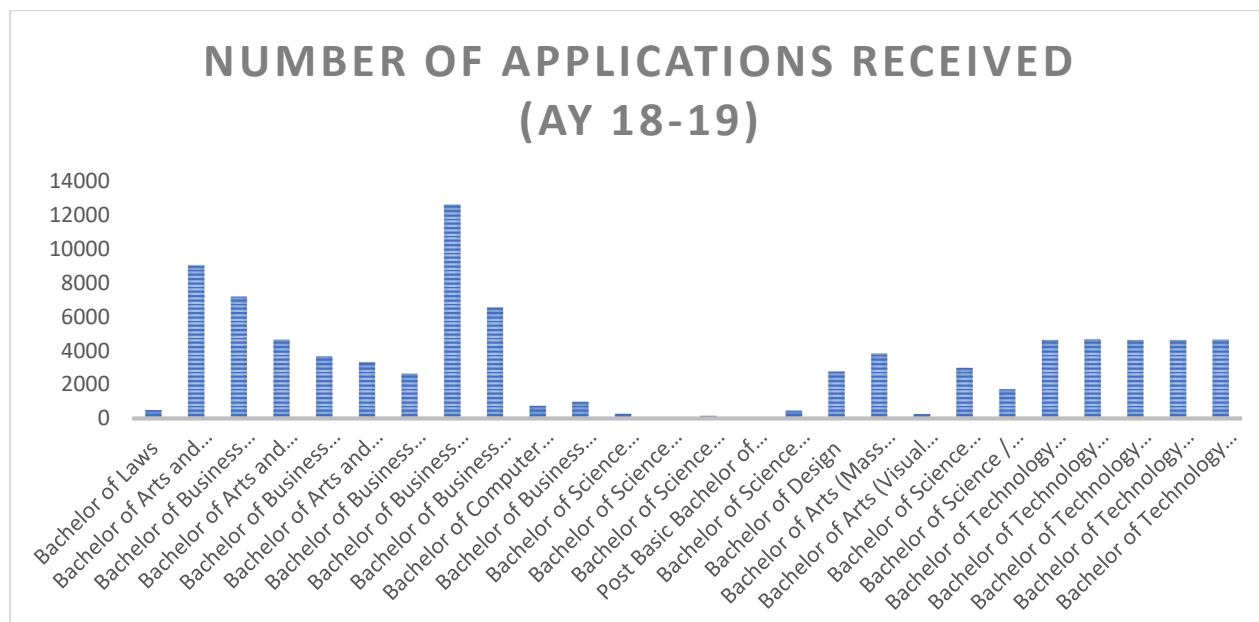
ADMISSIONS

The Symbiosis Test Secretariat (STS) is responsible for organising the entrance tests required for admission to various undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral programmes at SIU.

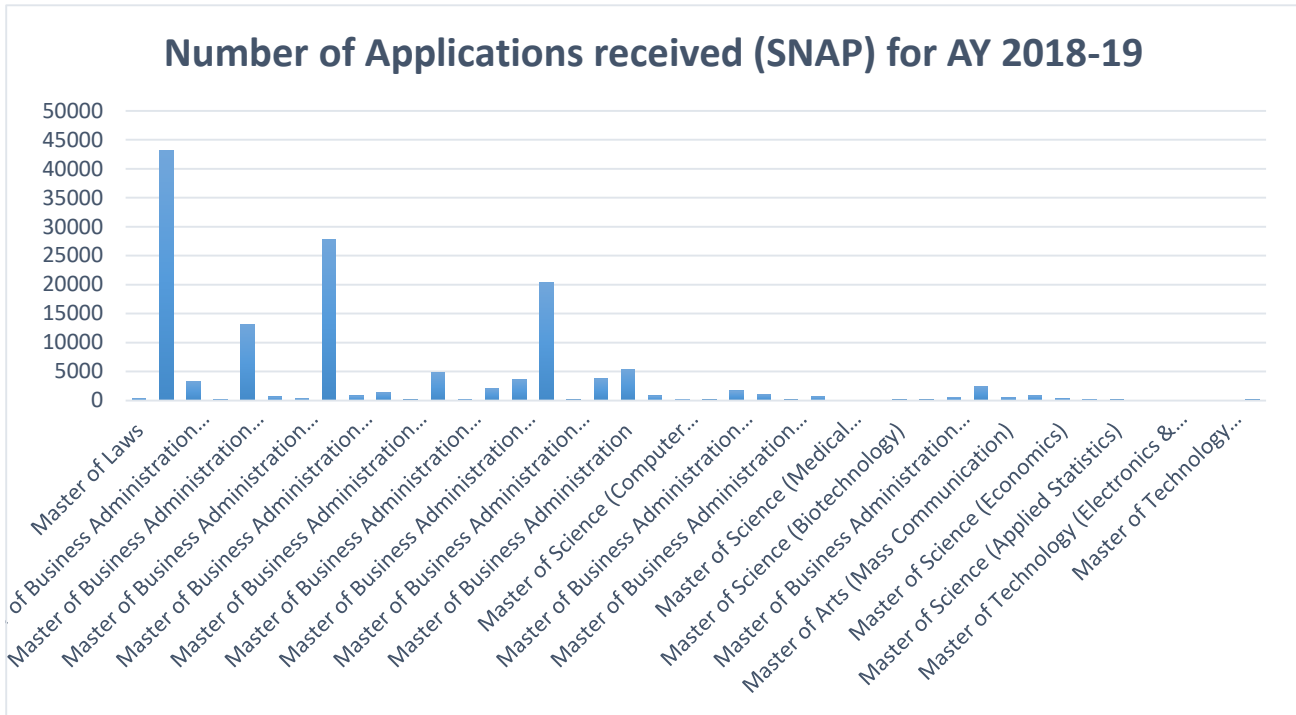
The Symbiosis National Aptitude Test (SNAP) is a common and mandatory written test for the admission to postgraduate programmes at SIU, whereas the Symbiosis Entrance Test- General (SET-General), SLAT (Symbiosis Law Admission Test), SIT EEE (SIT Engineering Entrance Exam) and SEED (Symbiosis Entrance Exam for Design), are mandatory for admission to undergraduate programmes at SIU. These entrance tests are conducted in various cities across India. After the test, a candidate needs to undergo the selection process of the desired institute to qualify for the admission to the programme of his/ her choice. Admissions for the Ph.D. programme are done through the Ph.D. Entrance Test (PET).

- SNAP is conducted on the 3rd Sunday of December
- SET is conducted on the 1st Saturday of May
- PET is conducted on the 4th Sunday of June

Library

The library at the main University campus is housed in an independent spacious building with high quality amenities and facilities. Institutes / departments located at other campuses have their own library, to cater to the learning and research needs of students and faculty members. All libraries are hubs of intellectual activity and are well-resourced with books, journals, periodicals and e- resources. The Library at the main campus has developed a portal to provide remote access to its e- resources for all. Wi-fi campuses enable 24x7 usage of e- resources, thus adding to the flexibility of students to study at their pace and time. The reading hall, IRC section and Periodical section of the central library at Lavale Campus is open 24x7 while circulation time is between 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m including Sunday. Libraries at the other campuses are open for extended hours during the examinations.

The University has implemented KOHA integrated library management software for all its Constituent units. OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) of books, and other reading materials are accessible from any location. Library has implemented RFID technology in 2018-19. The University subscribes to e-books which are made accessible to all institutes. The University also subscribed to 125 online databases as per the requirements of the institutes. EBSCO, Emerald, Scopus, JSTOR, Frost and Sullivan, EMIS are some of the major databases. The University spent total 1959.99 Lakhs on library resources.

Internationalisation



Internationalisation is in the DNA of Symbiosis and with Symbiosis' motto 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam', the Institution truly creates a 'Home away from Home' for foreign students in Pune.

Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE)

Dr. Vidya Yeravdekar is the Executive Director of the Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE). She spearheads the process of Internationalization at the university and has been instrumental in setting a centralized office for driving internationalization at all institutes under the aegis of Symbiosis International (Deemed University), (SIU).

SCIE was formalized through a Board of Management (BOM) resolution in February 2008. The resolution was a result of the discussion that took place in the BOM related to Internationalization of Symbiosis International (Deemed University). It was realized that although the admission procedure for International Students and students' related services and events have been streamlined to a great extent, efforts are to be made to internationalize the curricula and the profile of faculty and staff in the University.

SCIE is a department of the University, providing leadership and support for the University's efforts to internationalize the campus and the curricula. The mandate that has been given to Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE) is to streamline the processes related to International Collaborations, participation in International Conferences & Seminars, International Student Mobility, setting up of Area Study Centres, etc.

At Symbiosis, there are international students from over 85 countries who undertake undergraduate and postgraduate studies. Students and faculty are repeatedly provided with opportunities to pursue their international academic interests to the fullest, be it through academic exchanges, or exposure to international conferences, seminars, workshops, etc.

Internationalization at Symbiosis works on multiple tracks, hence, the three divisions in the Symbiosis Centre for International Education include:

1. International Promotions and International Student Relations
2. International Students' Admissions & Student Events
3. International Initiatives and Collaborations

International Promotions & International Student Relations

A. International Student Relations:

1. Meeting with International Students studying at Symbiosis International (Deemed University): The International Promotions department of SCIE conducts an informal discussion with students studying in each Institute of Symbiosis International (Deemed University). The International student relations meeting is conducted by the International Promotions & International Student Relations department.
2. Meeting with The Asia Foundation (TAF) Representatives – Kabul and Afghani Female students sponsored by TAF studying at Symbiosis: Mrs. Razia Stanikzai, Mrs. Freshta Habib and Ms. Shruti Patil visited Symbiosis campuses on Jan 8 and 9, 2019 to conduct meeting with Asia Foundation Scholars and they record their experiences and meet the faculty members to take feedback from each Asia Foundation scholar.
3. Buddy Appointment: The “buddy” is an Indian domestic student, who is familiar with the city of Pune. The “buddy” helps the international student to overcome challenges big or small – that are related to the institute and the University, as well as everyday problems related to settling down in India. The buddies are appointed by International student coordinator at each institute of Symbiosis after commencement of the degree program for International students.

B. International Promotions:

1. Collaboration with EDCIL (Educational Consultants India): Partnered for Study in India (SII) Initiative for second cycle for student enrolment under Study in India Scholarship Scheme (SII), Study in India (Africa Free-ship) Scheme, SIU scholarships for Study in India students, MEA Silver Jubilee Scholarship, General Scholarship Scheme and COMPEX scholarship by Indian Embassy in Nepal.
2. SCIE participates in Education fairs in Asia, Gulf and Africa. This year the department participated in education fairs in GETEX – UAE, Indonesia, Bhutan and Nepal through its representatives.
3. Delegation Visits: Representatives from Ministry of Adult Education from Kingdom of Bhutan visited to strengthen relations with Symbiosis.
4. Embassy Visits to promote SIU: Embassy of Republic of Uganda, Embassy of Chad, Embassy of Yemen, Embassy of Turkmenistan, Embassy of Ethiopia and Embassy of Republic of Genie.
5. ICT workshops for K-12 students in Bhutan and Nepal: Mr. Shehrevar Davierwala and Ms. Sonam Deki, SIT student from Bhutan conducted workshop at Nima High School and Kelki High School on website development approved by Ministry of Adult Education Bhutan and with Ms. Grishma Thapa a student from Nepal at SAB Public school, Kathmandu.

C. International Initiatives and Collaborations

The International Initiatives and Collaborations department of SCIE strives towards promoting internationalisation by facilitating student and faculty mobility, through different programs like Global Immersion Programme, Study Abroad programs, Long Term Engagement of Faculty, Scholar-in-Residence, International guest lectures, International conferences on varying topics related to Internationalisation of Higher Education initiating joint research with Foreign Universities.

Short term programs like the Study India Program, Summer Schools which are 2 to 4 weeks in duration cover a range of academic and cultural aspects. Annually, SCIE receives students from countries like Japan, Canada, USA, Australia, and Singapore.

Symbiosis International (Deemed University), (SIU) has partnered with International Universities to promote various forms of academic programs and initiatives. The University has collaborations with Universities in France, Germany, UK, USA, Canada, Japan, Singapore, Australia, Spain, Portugal, Taiwan, South Korea.

Student Program:

Incoming Students:

1. Summer Programs:

SCIE conducts summer programs for the foreign students. These programs vary from 4 to 6 weeks. This year SIU received students from Japan for Software Solution Design Program (customized program arranged at SICSR in association with SCIE).

2. Semester exchange:

Students from different SIU Institutes pursued a semester at SIU's partner institutions across the world under the Student Exchange Program. These students studied at Universities in Germany, UK, USA, Australia, Canada, Germany, Netherlands, Singapore, France, Portugal, Spain, Ireland and Japan.

3. Summer School

Outgoing Students:

1. Global Immersion Program-(GIP)

Under this initiative the SIU students are encouraged to study abroad for a semester, attend Summer Schools, Winter Schools and/or undertake internships with our partner Universities.

Symbiosis believes that when students undertake a semester abroad they develop intercultural competencies. Being able to interact and work with people from other backgrounds and cultures makes them employable in an international workplace. The University has designed programs to encourage outward mobility and credit transfers for the courses undertaken by the students during the GIP

Faculty Programs:

Scholar-In-Residence:

The Scholar-In-Residence Program is designed for International Faculty to come to Symbiosis for short term period of 1 to 3 months. Some of the activities that the Scholar is expected are conducting guest lecturers/workshops/symposia, participation in teaching, review and internationalizing the curriculum, development and evaluation of research, Faculty development program/ faculty seminar, conceptualizing-contributing and editing research journals, joint paper presentations in international conferences. This program was developed to share best academic practices, developing in house global competencies and international linkages with foreign Universities.

Research

Research Publications

The University has focused and made consistent efforts in the last 9 to 10 years to encourage the faculty members to undertake research and publish the same in good scholarly journals indexed in Scopus and Web of Science. The number of such publications has increased substantially from 25 in 2010-11 to 1732 as of 31st May 2019.

In the AY 2018-19, a total of 582 research papers were published, of which 332 were published in top journals indexed in Scopus, Web of Science, Science Citation Index (SCI), Social Science Citation Index (SSCI), Arts & Humanities Citation Index (AHCI) and Emerging Source Citation Index (ESCI) as shown in the Table. Over a period of time, the number of citations, h-index and i10-index of SIU research publications are also increasing exponentially thereby indicating the quality.

As regards to intellectual property, SIU till date has filed 21 national and international patents, of which 14 patents have been published.

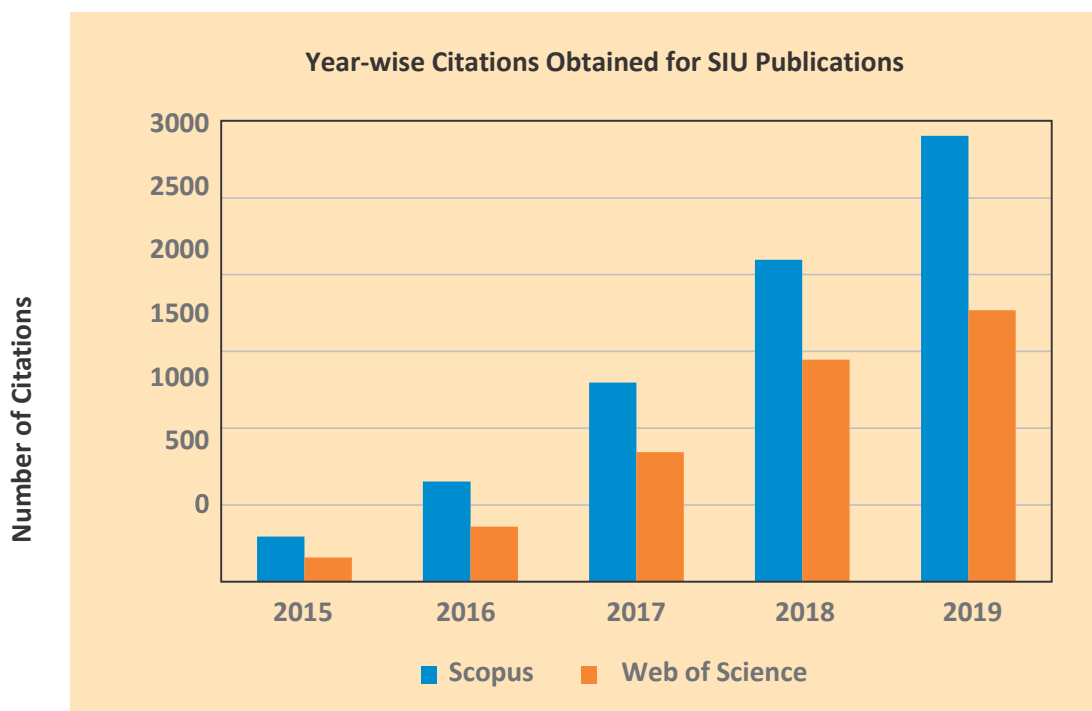

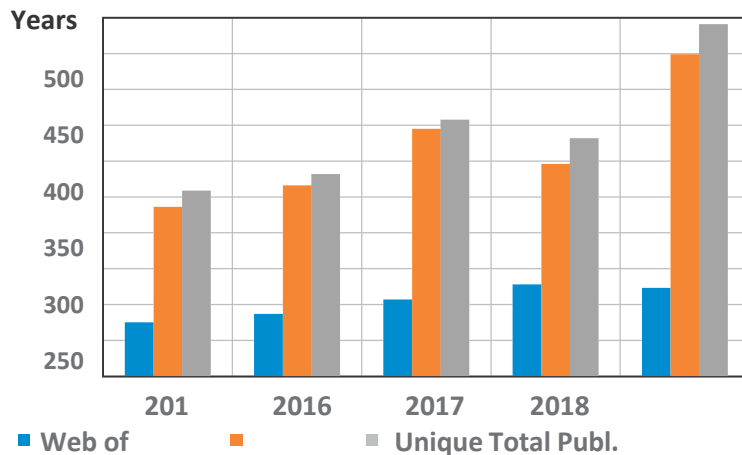

The centre has installed systems for on-site segregation and processing of waste resources including wet, and dry waste and wastewater in the university campus. SCWRM is committed towards developing and demonstrating in-house sustainable waste resource management systems on-campus to develop a waste-free and Dumping Yard Free campus.

The various waste management and processing systems installed on campus through SCWRM include biogas, composting, plastic bottle shredding machine, sewage treatment plant and reed-beds and plastic and waste oil processing reactors. In addition, there are tie-ups with other processing partners for management of plastic and e-waste. Besides, the centre, provides technical advice and consultancy to industry and other stakeholders including Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC). SCWRM carried out projects with PMC include (i) Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) of 25 MSW based biogas plants running within Pune municipal limits (ii) Inspection of these biogas plants for current status and recommendations for improving operational and performance efficiency, (iii) GIS mapping of MSW collection vehicles and awareness creation among MSW personnel. SCWRM conducts training and awareness programs for decentralized processing of household waste to create eco-friendly compost at apartments and society level. SCWRM is also engaged in conducting research on developing and improving technologies for waste resource processing and developing need-based, user-friendly, and cost-effective solutions. This is being done through in-house research activities and interdisciplinary as well as national and international research collaborations. Upright and inverted phase-contrast microscopes with digital imaging facility, incubator shakers, chemical reactors, laminar air flow cabinet, high capacity distiller, lab



scale working biogas model, etc., are a few of the major equipment as research facilities available at SCWRM.

The centre has taken social initiatives for benefit of society by disseminating the low-cost, 'NisargLaxmi' concept of composting, and bio-culture developed by the centre, for household organic waste processing. The concept is being implemented in the University's adopted 5 villages for decentralized organic waste processing under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. The centre provides training and demonstrations for using the NisargLaxmi concept for interested stakeholders like individual citizen and societies free of cost. The centre conducts awareness and sensitization sessions for schools.

SYMBIOSIS CENTRE FOR NANOSCIENCE AND NANOTECHNOLOGY (SCNN)

Symbiosis Centre for Nanoscience and Nanotechnology (SCNN) was established in the year 2017 with specific focus on developing cutting-edge translational research in the field of Nanotechnology. SCNN focuses on breakthrough research activities particularly in the field of advanced materials for drug delivery, biomedical diagnostic devices, etc. Spurred by recent progress in materials chemistry and drug delivery, stimuli-responsive devices that deliver a drug in spatial, temporal and dosage controlled fashion have become possible. In drug delivery science, the particular interest is in the synthesis of stimuli responsive (pH and temperature) materials such as Mesoporous Silica for controlled release of drugs. Furthermore, work based on bio-polymer nanoparticles such as Chitosan, applications of magnetic and ferroelectric nanoparticles for hyperthermia and nanogenerator a utility for biomedical devices are under progress.

SCNN researchers collaborate with industry/hospital to focus on developing better, faster, and more affordable medical/diagnostic devices. Current research is focused on biomedical optics for early detection of diseases with emphasis on various types of cancer. This study involves the development of devices based on surface enhanced Raman Spectroscopy (SERS) and fiber optic Raman probes. In addition to this, work oriented on cost effective electrochemical sensor development for medical diagnosis is under progress.

SYMBIOSIS CENTRE FOR STEM CELL RESEARCH (SCSCR)

The centre is a unique research centre in Pune that performs research exclusively on stem cells. Primarily several areas of research in Experimental Hematology at a cellular and molecular level would be carried out with respect to aging of stem cells, microenvironment –mediated regulation of hematopoietic stem cells, leukemia/lymphoma biology, development of 3D cultures, mesenchymal stem cell biology with special focus on exosomes and micro-vesicles and signal transduction. Consecutively, research would be extended towards induced pluripotent stem cell biology with a special reference to targeted differentiation towards specific lineages and development of disease models. Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Ministry of Science & Technology, Government of India has identified Stem Cell Research as one of the most exciting fields of life science in view of its potential clinical applications. With this understanding Symbiosis Centre for Stem Cell Research will serve in strengthening research in one of the targeted areas as identified by DBT's Medical Biotechnology programme.

SYMBIOSIS CENTER FOR MEDICAL IMAGE ANALYSIS (SCMIA)

As Medical Imaging has entered into an information era, there has been an increased impetus to understand and quantify the complex information conveyed by biomedical images. Modern computational methods offer the potential for extracting diverse and complex information from imaging data thus quantifying them precisely and therefore overcoming limitations of subjective visual interpretation, and for finding imaging patterns that relate to pathologies as well as aiding treatment planning. These techniques are an invisible aspect of modern clinical studies and therefore should be given immense importance. There is lack of a multidisciplinary ecosystem in a single institution and lack of image analysis and clinical studies to India targeting specific healthcare problems and pathologies. Envisioning these challenges Symbiosis International University has established a Centre in Medical Image Analysis which will act as a research niche for Symbiosis and attract researchers, physicists and clinicians across the world. The major goals of the centre are the development of novel computer-based image analysis methods, and their applications to a wide variety of clinical research studies and to translate the techniques to the clinic thereby aiding early diagnosis and understanding of the underlying pathology.

SYMBIOSIS CENTRE FOR BEHAVIOURAL STUDIES (SCBS)

SCBS has been established to intensify the thrust of behavioural research scholarship within Symbiosis International (Deemed University). SCBS focuses on improving the well-being of the society, through a deeper understanding of their lifestyles, by employing paradigm diversity in their research methods, careful to maintain rigour in theory and method, eventually disseminating these findings to relevant stakeholders for a larger social good. It encourages research in functions such as Healthcare, Sales and Marketing, International Relations, Personnel Management, Communication, Media and Design amongst others. It also finds applications in Criminology, Sociology, Politics and Anthropology. The three main areas of research currently pursued at SCBS are 1) Pro-Social Behaviour 2) Pro-Health Behaviour and 3) Behavioural Studies in Higher Education. SCBS is guided by an Advisory Committee for Research Centres (ACRC) which comprises of highly accomplished stalwarts from academia. SCBS has catered to over 1500 hours in training and over 2000 hours in research to students and scholars from design, media and communication, management, humanities and social sciences, health sciences and cognitive psychology. Resource persons include reputed international faculty and practitioners like regional head at Tobii and from universities of Texas A&M University - U.S.A, Bond University - Australia, Technische Hochschule Nürnberg, Germany and University of Konstanz, Germany. In the Academic year 2018-19, the SCBS lab had visitors from reputed universities in Germany, France and Indian institutes like IIT-K and TISS. SCBS labs also aided one summer intern and one masters dissertation student from SSE. Some of the Dr. Preetha Menon of SCBS was a visitor by invitation to these universities on teaching and research assignments over the last year.

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES

Faculty Development Programmes have always been conducted to enhance the teaching skills and research capabilities of the faculty members. The Department had organised 67 programs which were attended by 2127 Faculty members from SIU. Some of the Topics on which FDP's were conducted are, Andragogy and Research Methodology, MATLAB basics, Adopting ICT in Teaching -learning Pedagogy, Introduction to Python, Holistic Professional Development. The New Perspective:

In the academic year 2018-19, it was proposed to create formal training programmes to train the faculty of the University on Teaching-Learning-Evaluation (Andragogy) and Research Methodology. The span of this course is 10 days which is referred as the 10- day FDP on Andragogy and Research Methodology.

Training and development interventions at STLRC are critical to capacity building. For sustained benefits, the activities of this department should go beyond discrete training programs and encompass other interventions that are continuous, relevant and goal oriented.

The goals that emerge are as follows:

- Capacity building of faculty for Teaching-Learning- Assessment/ Evaluation
- Capacity building of faculty for Research
- Implementation of the Outcome based Education model across SIU
- Optimization of academic resource utilization

Taking these goals into consideration, it was proposed and approved in the Deans council that Symbiosis Teaching Learning Resource Centre (STLRC) will offer a 10 day Faculty Development Program (FDP) covering areas of Teaching, Learning, Evaluation and Research Methods. This 10 day FDP is a part of the Quality Improvement Program (QIP) of Symbiosis International (Deemed University).

STLRC has offered 7 batches of the said FDP since October 2018 till May 2019. Close to 200 faculty members were benefitted by this FDP.

Symbiosis Centre for Alumni Engagement (SCAE) was established in 2017 to create and maintain a life-long connection between the Symbiosis and its alumni.
